Scrutiny Review – Role of Inclusion in Schools	
<b>Achieved since last meeting</b>	<p>The Committee has agreed that the review focus on understanding the Council's role in supporting inclusion and school's approaches to this issue.</p> <p>The meeting in March was used to consider the views of Outwood Academy Trust, Northern Education Trust, and Carmel Trust.</p> <p>A number of visits have taken place to local schools, alternative provision, and Schools and SEN services. This included considering the operation of the Pupil Inclusion Panel.</p> <p>The Committee has also considered information from a DfE Professional Adviser for SEND, and Ofsted.</p> <p>During the review a Call for Evidence was issued by the Department for Education (DfE) on exclusions and the Committee submitted a response in conjunction with the Cabinet Member.</p> <p>A Call for Evidence has also been issued in relation to Elective Home Education, and the Committee has also agreed to submit a response to this.</p>
