The Committee will be exploring the following key lines of enquiry: • What measures and processes do SBC and its partners have in place to raise awareness amongst key agencies and the wider communities to identify and tackle hate crime? • How well are the key agencies working together? • How do we measure the effectiveness of activities to raise awareness and provide support? • Do we benchmark performance? • Are the current priorities and measures in the Hate Crime Action Plan appropriate? • How hate crime is recorded and what are the reasons for under-reporting? • What is the reported incidence of hate crime in the Borough compared with other areas and is there correlation with numbers of minority groups? • What support is needed to encourage victims to report incidences of hate crime? • What is the impact of hate crime? • What is the impact of hate crime? • What is the role and impact of social media? • Why do hate crimes occur and how can hate crime be prevented? • What is third party reporting? The September meeting heard from various groups providing support for people with protected characteristics. Eight organisation attended for a workshop style session. The final evidence gathering meeting in October will be focusing on work in schools.
