NHS Updates / Consultations	
<b>Key Issues / Problems or concerns</b>	<p><b>Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP) / Integrated Care System (ICS)</b></p> <p>The statutory Joint Committee has been formed by all seven affected Authorities (including North Yorkshire) in order to consider proposals emanating from the STP/ Integrated Care System process.</p> <p>Foundation Trust Chief Executives attended the meeting on 27 November, and it was noted that new proposals for the configuration of hospital services would be brought forward for consultation in the new year.</p> <p><b>Skerne Medical Group, Sedgefield</b></p> <p>This GP Practice has registered patients from the Wynyard area. The Practice faces a substantial shortage of GP sessions from February 2019 and has assessed options for the future. The relevant CCG has approved plans to close a branch surgery in Trimdon Village, but the base at Sedgefield has been retained. Durham Council's Health Committee will continue to monitor future developments.</p> <p><b>Tees Respite and Short Breaks Review</b></p> <p>Middlesbrough and Redcar and Cleveland Councils have made referrals to the Secretary of State on this matter. Any future changes to services will be monitored by Tees Valley Committee following the completion of the referral process.</p>

The Group has completed its work and will agree its report in new year.</p> <p><b>Regional Committee</b> – This Committee is now chaired by South Tyneside Council for 2018-19. The meeting on 7 September agreed to consider further the issue of NHS interpretation and translation services and this was examined further on 27 November. NEAS also attended and provided a regional update.</p>
