Scrutiny Review – Protection of Vulnerable Older Residents Living at Home	
<b>Achieved since last meeting</b>	<p>In February 2019, the Executive Scrutiny Committee agreed to refer this issue to the Committee for further review following concerns in relation to crimes in local neighbourhoods, specifically those against vulnerable older people living at home.</p> <p>The Committee considered and agreed a scope and plan at its meeting in March 2019. With a particular focus on those aged 80 and above, the review would aim to understand:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• the wider context of crime data and police resources in the Borough;</li> <li>• how key local service providers promote the safety and wellbeing of vulnerable residents living in their homes;</li> <li>• the role of the voluntary and community sector;</li> <li>• local community-based initiatives to promote community safety.</li> </ul>

<b>Planned next month</b>	<p>The first evidence-gathering session for this review will take place at the next Committee meeting in July 2019, with scheduled contributions from SBC Adult Social Care, SBC One Call and Thirteen Housing Group.
