The Globe

Detail

1. The decision of Cabinet, taken on 27th June 2019 in relation to the Globe Restoration has been subject to a valid call in. The call-in applies to the decision made as follows:-

RESOLVED that subject to funding being made available by Council, the allocation of £6.5m be agreed to progress completion of the Globe restoration project to enable completion by late 2020 and recommend to Council that additional prudential borrowing of £6.5m be approved at a cost of £325k per annum.

2. The call-in is only applicable to Cabinet's decision to 'progress completion of the Globe restoration project to enable completion by late 2020' and not the decision made by Council on the 27th June 2019 which authorized additional prudential borrowing of £6.5m at a cost of £325k per annum.
3. The reasons for call in relate to the following principles of decision making:
 - An explanation of what options have been considered and giving the reasons for decisions;
 - Proportionality (i.e. that the action must be proportionate to the desired outcome);
 - Due Consultation and the taking of professional advice from officers.
