

## Crime and Disorder Select Committee Chair's Update – October 2019

<b>Scrutiny Review – Protection of Vulnerable Older Residents Living at Home</b>	
<b>Achieved since last meeting</b>	<p>The meeting in September 2019 considered evidence from Cleveland Police, the Office of the Police and Crime Commissioner, and Cleveland Fire Brigade. This included an overall crime context / data for Cleveland and the Borough of Stockton-on-Tees, service delivery and resources, promotion of safety and wellbeing, and partnership working.</p> <p>At the last meeting in October 2019 (16<sup>th</sup>), the Committee received information from representatives of Catalyst, Age UK Teesside and the Stockton-on-Tees Over 50s Forum.</p>
<b>Problems or concerns</b>	None.
<b>Planned next month</b>	The Committee will be considering a summary of evidence received in relation to this review at an informal meeting in November 2019, where draft recommendations will also be formulated.

<b>Councillor Call for Action (CCfA) – Obstructive and Illegal Parking around Whitehouse Primary School</b>	
<b>Achieved since last meeting</b>	Following approval of this CCfA request at the last Executive Scrutiny Committee in July 2019, it has been agreed to dedicate the 24 <sup>th</sup> October 2019 meeting to consider this issue in further detail. An Officer meeting has taken place to identify who will be required to attend and invitations have been circulated.
<b>Problems or concerns</b>	None.
<b>Planned next month</b>	<p>The Committee meeting on the 24<sup>th</sup> October 2019 will receive contributions from Ward Councillors (who submitted the CCfA request), Local Authority Officers, Whitehouse Primary School personnel, and any identified representatives of affected residents.</p> <p>It is also intended for Committee Members to undertake a visit to the school to gain a greater understanding of the geography in question.</p> <p>In related matters, the Committee will receive a further progress update in relation to outstanding recommendations from the review of School Parking at the October 2019 (24<sup>th</sup>) meeting.</p>
