<b>Key Issues / Problems or concerns</b>	<p><b>CQC Report Updates:</b> these continue to be considered on a quarterly basis. The last report (Q2) was presented to the Committee at the November 2019 meeting.</p> <p><b>CQC Annual Update:</b> this is scheduled for Committee in January 2020.</p> <p><b>Teeswide Safeguarding Adults Board (TSAB) Annual Report:</b> this was considered by the Committee at the last meeting in December 2019. Members raised a number of concerns and queries around several topics, including domestic abuse, Deprivation of Liberty Safeguards (DoLS), Adults and Children's Social Care sometimes being at odds with each other, safeguarding within care homes, and access to training. Some ideas to incorporate into future Annual Reports were also suggested.</p>

<b>Key Issues / Problems or concerns</b>	<p><b>Sustainability and Transformation Plan (STP) / Integrated Care System (ICS)</b></p> <p>The statutory Joint Committee has been formed by all seven affected Authorities (including North Yorkshire) in order to consider proposals emanating from the STP / Integrated Care System process.</p> <p>Due to the General Election, the scheduled meeting of this Joint Committee on the 26<sup>th</sup> November 2019 was cancelled. A replacement date early in the New Year is intended.</p>
<b>Requests for more information</b>	The STP Committee will receive information on the development of Primary Care Networks at a future meeting.
