Scrutiny Review – Hospital Discharge	
Achieved since last meeting	<p>A draft Action Plan in relation to the agreed recommendations within the final report of the Hospital Discharge (Phase 1) review was considered and subsequently approved by the Committee in December 2020. At this meeting, representatives from North Tees and Hartlepool NHS Foundation Trust also provided an initial response to the comments raised via the Committee's Care Home Survey that was undertaken as part of the review's first phase.</p> <p>Evidence-gathering for phase 2 (discharge to an individual's own home) resumed in December 2020 and involved contributions from Healthwatch Stockton-on-Tees, the Council's Carers Service and Eastern Ravens.</p>
