Scrutiny Review – Child Poverty	
Achieved since last meeting	<p>The review will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Collate and analyse data • Identify potential solutions • Focus on a range of linked issues including digital divide, FSM eligibility • Review the approaches in other areas • Result in the basis of a child / family poverty strategy for adoption by the Council <p>A series of themes meeting are planned over the year.</p> <p>In July, the Select Committee received introductory presentations from the North East Child Poverty Committee and Public Health. This provided some important context for the review and included definitions of child poverty together with data setting out the national and regional picture, causes of child poverty and impact.</p> <p>The September meeting focused on income poverty and a presentation was received from Ian Bartlett from Stockton and District Advice and Information Service and Chair of the Infinity Partnership. The presentations highlighted the types of enquiries into the Service, food bank take-up and the impact of benefit changes. A presentation was also received from Martin Gray on a new approach which was being developed to tackle inequality in the Borough. The work complemented the scrutiny review which was highlighted as an element of the work.</p> <p>The October meeting had to be cancelled at short notice due to contributors not being able to attend.
