DRAFT - ADULTS' STRATEGY

SUMMARY

Stockton-On-Tees Borough Council is developing a new Adult Social Care Strategy for the Borough. A DRAFT of the document, which has been developed to date in consultation with colleagues in the Council and externally with residents is attached at Appendix 1. Before the document is developed further, we are seeking the Board's views on the DRAFT document's proposed vision, objectives and the proposed overall approach for the future of Adult Social Care in Stockton-On-Tees. We plan to return to Board with the final DRAFT prior to sign off by Cabinet and Council later in 2017.
