## **HEALTH AND WELLBEING UPDATE**

##### **Childhood Brain Damage prevalence**

1. The Group received a presentation on the above and agreed that establishing if a child had ever had a head injury or neurological illness was essential if the correct support for families was to be provided.

##### **Eastern Ravens – Big Lottery Fund Bid**

2. Members provided valuable input to assist with a big lottery bid for funding to help identify hidden young carers.

##### **0 – 19 Service**

3. The Group received a presentation from the Harrogate and District NHS Foundation Trust and Family Action who had been commissioned to provide the Council's 0 -19 service.
