## Scrutiny Review of Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder (FASD)

### Summary

1. The Committee is requested to consider the information from Education Improvement, Early Years, Youth, and Licensing services.
2. The purpose of the meeting is to understand the role of these services, and to see what FASD prevention work is being and/or could be undertaken as part of their work.

### Detail

3. At the last meeting of the Committee, Members considered information from representatives of the locally based FASD Network UK charity, and the NHS Foundation Trust.
4. Representatives of the following have been invited to this meeting:
  - Education Improvement Service
  - SBC Early Years
  - A Commissioned Children's Centre provider
  - Youth Services Preventions
  - Licensing
5. Five secondary schools and eight primary schools (including special education schools) have attended school specific FASD training sessions, and one primary school attended the multi-agency briefing (referred to in the FASD summary report at **Appendix 1**).
6. The Education Improvement Service provides a Risk Taking Toolkit for use in secondary schools. An overview of this is provided at **Appendix 2**. This is due to be updated to include specific information on FASD.
