 - Youth Services Preventions
 - Licensing
- 5. Five secondary schools and eight primary schools (including special education schools) have attended school specific FASD training sessions, and one primary school attended the multi-agency briefing (referred to in the FASD summary report at **Appendix 1**).
- 6. The Education Improvement Service provides a Risk Taking Toolkit for use in secondary schools. An overview of this is provided at **Appendix 2**. This is due to be updated to include specific information on FASD.
