

Scrutiny Review of Disadvantage in Early Years and School

Summary

This meeting will enable the Committee to discuss engagement with Early Years Services, and the role of health.

Detail

1. This meeting will cover the theme of family engagement with Early Years provision, and the role of health services, to inform the Committee's review (scope attached).
2. Representatives from Early Years Services, Public Health, North Tees and Hartlepool NHS Foundation Trust, and Tees, Esk and Wear Valleys NHS Foundation Trust will be in attendance.
3. At the meeting the Committee will be briefed on the Fairer Start project. This project is focussed on Stockton Town Centre Ward, and is a three year pilot scheme aimed at improving outcomes for 0-3 year olds including social and emotional development, speech and language, and nutrition.
