# TRAINING UPTAKE

### **HEALTH & SAFETY**

Attached are details of the year-end totals for corporate, bespoke and on-line (e-learning) tuition for 2016-2017 and for quarter 1 of 2017-2018.

- For 2016-2017, 49 health and safety training courses were delivered to 749 candidates.
- For 2017-2018 (Q1), 14 health and safety training courses were delivered to 141 candidates.

The frequency of refresher training varies, with the general exception of First Aid training which should not exceed a period of three years. For other topics, refresher training should be provided at 'regular intervals' [HSE HSG 65].

With the exception of asbestos awareness training, we do not actively monitor training – this is a responsibility delegated to Managers under the corporate health and safety policy.
