





- Business Clinics initiative for the future






Partnership Working

North East England Chamber of Commerce

- Established in 1815 and operated continuously (Stockton Chamber formed 1862)
- Approximately 3000 members region wide
- The only regional Chamber of Commerce, funded by member subscriptions
- Services to Members include Events,
 Commercial Services, Policy and International Trade
- Run the Department of International Trade contract for the North East



Tees Valley

- Office in Middlesbrough
- Area Meetings take place in all Local Authority Areas to inform members and receive their views
- A team of Membership Advisors on the ground meeting regularly with members
- Policy Team Activity Including Education and Skills, Energy, Transport
- Represent the Business Organisations on the TVCA Board with "Enhanced Observer" status
- There to represent the views of Members



Specific Engagement with Stockton

- Meet with Chief Executive on a quarterly basis
- Run the Stockton Business Forum in partnership with the Council
- Give assistance on Awards presentations etc
- Provided assistance with Inward Investment Enquiries (when asked)
- Specific responses to consultations
- Statutory Consultees in the Budget process each year
- Offered support on specific projects (e.g. Hilton)



What could improve?

- Not a huge amount generally good
- The Team can tend to keep things to themselves
- Must be more opportunity to collaborate on inward investment
- Need to improve Stockton Business Forum



Relationship with Other Local Authorities

- Regular contact is more patchy but all willing
- More involved in other areas on specific projects e.g. Towns
 Fund
- Resources can be an issue
- Different models mean different engagement e.g. Sit on the Board of Business Durham
