PLA 35/22 **Evacuation Procedure**

The Committee noted the evacuation and housekeeping procedure.

PLA 36/22 **Declarations of Interest**

There were no declarations of interest.

PLA 37/22 **Minutes- 21 November 2022**

AGREED the minutes of the meeting held on 21 November 2022 be confirmed as a correct record and signed by the Chair.

PLA 38/22 **Monitoring the Impact of Previously Agreed Recommendations - Progress report for the previously completed Business Support and Engagement review.**

The Select Committee considered a progress update including assessments of progress following implementation of the recommendations from the Business Support and Engagement review. The overall aim of the review had been to examine the Council's overall business support / engagement role, how this was utilised and viewed externally, and whether the necessary resources were in place to satisfy existing and future demand. This was the second time the update had been presented to the Committee. There were three outstanding recommendations.

The Committee was pleased with the progress that had been made with the outstanding actions.

The 'Invest in Stockton-on-Tees' website was highlighted as a useful resource. The Committee requested the following:

- That the names of Council Officers referred to in the update were removed and replaced with Officers' job titles instead.

AGREED that:

- 1) the Progress Update be noted, and the assessments of progress be confirmed.
- 2) the Action Plan in relation to the recommendations from the previously completed Scrutiny Review of Business Support and Engagement review be signed-off as fully achieved (no further updates required).

PLA 39/22 Scrutiny Review of Planning (Development Management) & Adoption of Open Space

Consideration was given to the draft final report and recommendations.

The link officer provided an overview of the review's aims, key findings, and recommendations.

The Chair of the Committee commended the planning service.

The Committee highlighted that the site visits had been valuable and requested that this was included in the scrutiny end of term report.

The Committee requested that:

- A reference to the Scrutiny Review of Tree Asset Management, which had been undertaken by the Crime and Disorder Select Committee, was included in the key findings section of the report.
- Officers checked that the public link to Maps@Stockton was accessible and provided the necessary information.
- A deadline of around nine months was set for the completion of recommendation 4 – the addition of information on those responsible for the maintenance of open space to Maps@Stockton. An additional database of information in the format of a word document was also requested.
- That the order of recommendations was altered so that recommendations 3 and 5 were exchanged.

AGREED that the final report be approved for submission to Cabinet.

PLA 40/22 Chair's Update and Work Programme 2022-2023

Consideration was given to the Work Programme.

The next meeting would be held on 27 February 2023.

The Committee requested that a further update on land acquisition as part of the Scrutiny Review of Burial Provision be provided by March 2023.
