RE: Egglescliffe & Eaglescliffe Neighbourhood Plan Area Application

The purpose of this letter is to apply to Stockton Borough Council (SBC) for designation of a neighbourhood plan area in accordance with Regulation 5 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012. This application is made by Egglescliffe & Eaglescliffe Parish Council (E&EC), which as a Parish Council is a relevant body for the purposes of section 61G(2) of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 (as amended by the Localism Act 2011).

E&EC intends to progress with the creation of a Neighbourhood Plan for its area; a working party for the progression of this plan has been established and the proposed plan will guide development in the proposed designated area in accordance with the provisions of the Localism Act, the National Planning Policy Framework, and SBC's Core Strategy. E&EC has approved the proposed boundary and finds it appropriate and practical to develop the neighbourhood plan for the Parish Council's entire administrative area and without seeking to create a neighbourhood plan in conjunction with adjoining Parish Councils. A map of the proposed area, as outlined in red, is enclosed.

E&EC formally requests that SBC acknowledge the intention to produce a Neighbourhood Plan for Egglescliffe and Eaglescliffe and confirm agreement to the area that the proposed plan will cover.
