#### **SUMMARY**

This report informs Members of the completion of the Five Year Deliverable Housing Supply Final Assessment 2015 – 2020

## **BACKGROUND**

The report, which uses a base date of 31 March 2015, shows that the authority has a deliverable housing supply of 4.50 years with a 20% buffer added, which is a shortfall of 374 dwellings. This means that the authority is not able to demonstrate a five year supply of deliverable housing sites.
