



PLANTING SHOULD TAKE THE FORM OF SHRUB PLANTING EITHER AS A HEDGE OR MIXED SHRUBBERY. THIS SHOULD ALLOW FOR APPROXIMATELY 75% EVERGREEN PLANTING CONTINUING THE SOFTENING EFFECT THROUGH THE WINTER AND EARLY SPRING. ALL PLANTING SHOULD BE CARRIED OUT IN A 400mm MINIMUM DEPTH OF TOPSOIL AND SUITABLE RELIABLE AND EASY TO PRUNE EVERGREEN PLANTING SHRUB SPECIES COULD INCLUDE ELAEAGNUS EBBINGE AND ELAEAGNUS PUNGENS 'MACULATA', ESCALLONIA 'EDINENSIS' AND ESCALLONIA 'INGRAMII' AND VIBURNUM TINUS. EACH SHRUB SHOULD BE SET AT 450mm SPACING.
