**Londonderry Bridge, Durham Road, Stockton-on-Tees  
Demolition and rebuilding of Londonderry Bridge as part of the wider Lustrum Beck Flood Alleviation Partnership Scheme, the purpose of which is to reduce the risk of flooding to the communities along Lustrum Beck.**

**UPDATE REPORT**

Since the original report the local planning authority has received notification from Historic England that they had received an application to add the structure to the List of Buildings of Special Architectural or Historic Interest.

Historic England completed an initial assessment of the building, based on the material provided in the application. The report concluded that this early-C19 bridge lacks the level of architectural or historic interest required to meet the criteria for listing in a national context.

The Secretary of State considered the advice and recommendation of Historic England, and decided not to take the application forward to a full assessment.

Historic England advised that the structure will therefore not be added to the List at this time.
