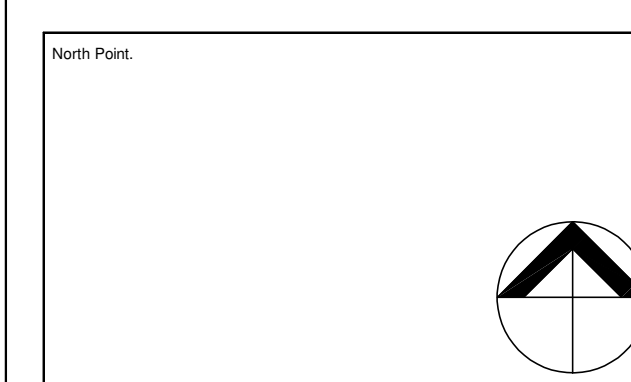
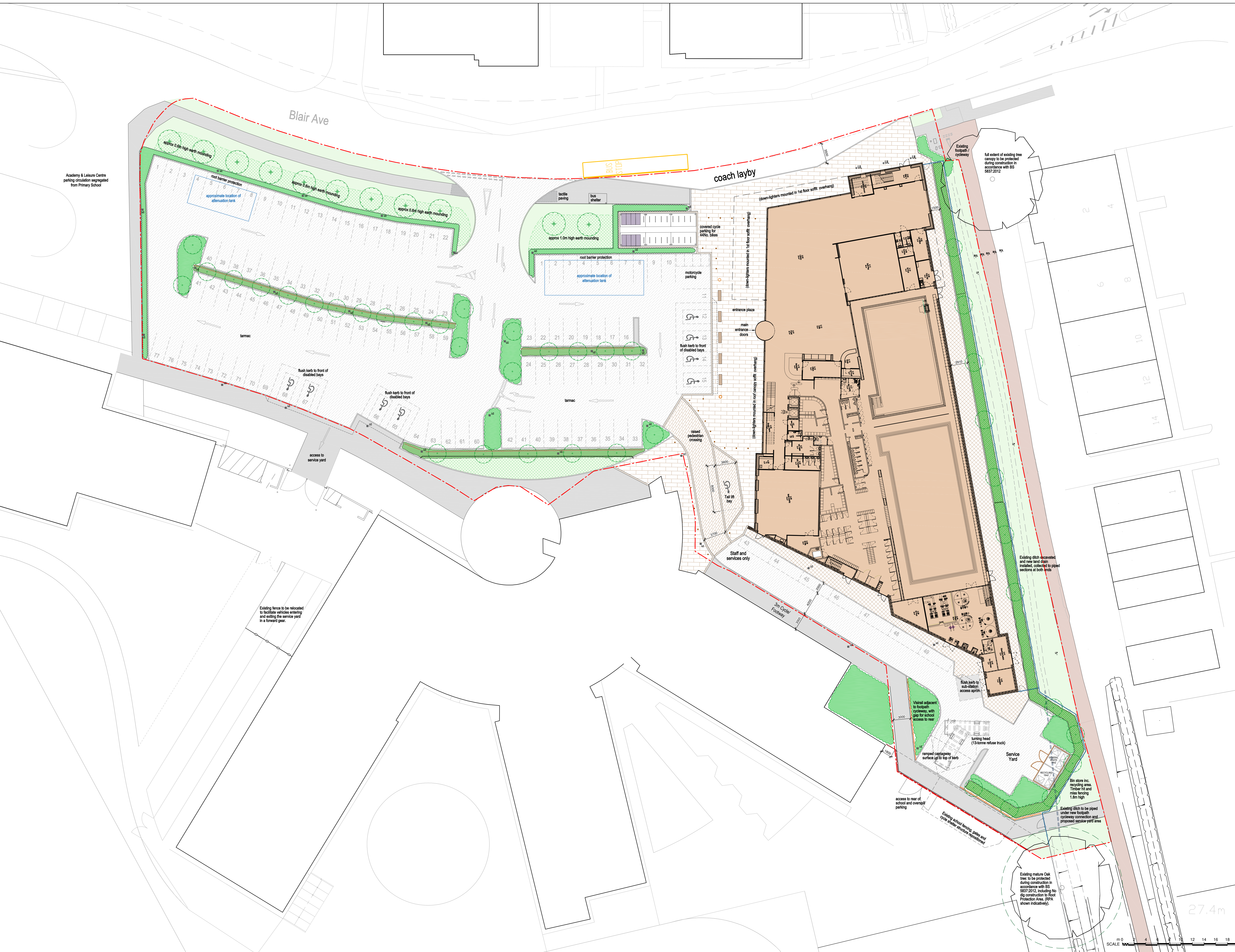

 - Semi Mature boulevard tree planting to Blair Avenue - 75% consists 'Downspiral' with root barriers as required adjacent to services.

 - Beech hedge (1m high)
 - Shrub planting
