PLANNING PERFORMANCE

Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to update members on the current performance of Planning Development Services for the last two quarters of 2016/2017 and the cumulative total for the year.

Recommendation

That planning committee note this six monthly and annual report.

Background

- 1. In February 2016 the Planning Committee decided that the future reporting of performance to committee would be on a six monthly basis. The performance level for this year therefore remains at 75% for majors, 80% for minors, 88% for other applications and 75% for County matters.
- 2. The reporting timeframe runs from 1st April-31st March each year. This report presents the performance of the last two quarters of 2016/2017 and the cumulative total for the year.

Current performance position

3. Performance results achieved for the year 2016/17 are 88.46% for major applications, 85.95% for minor, 93.6% for others and there were no County matters applications dealt with in that time frame. The results for the year *are as shown in tables 1, 2, 3 and 4 and chart 1.*

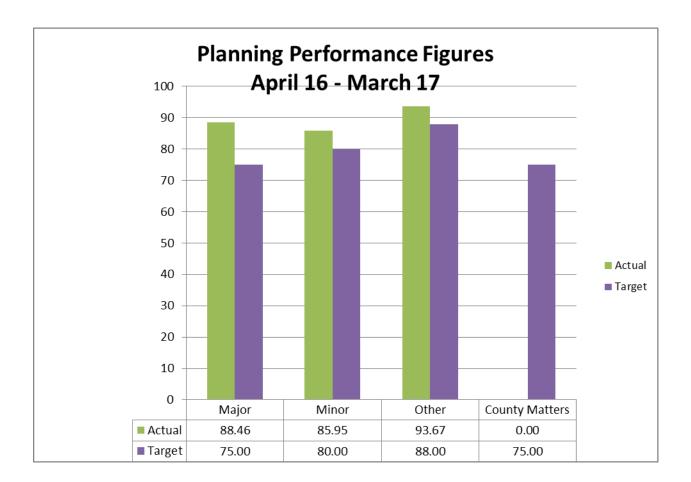
