## **UPDATE REPORT**

Since the original report, further responses have been received from the following two addresses with the comments summarised below:

## ADDITION NEIGHBOUR CONSULTATION RESPONSES

### Comments relate to

- Wrong location for a Crematorium
- Concerns over the larger amount of traffic adding to the already large amount that occurs via Tesco and Jewson's Builders which will be a safety hazard
- Fumes and dust from the traffic.
- It is suggested that there should either be a pedestrian phase on traffic lights at entrance to crematorium from Junction Road or clear signage at the two crossing points that are reported to remove the need for that pedestrian phase.
- In the safety audit reference is made to relocating the bus stop near to the proposed entrance to the crematorium. This is currently not in service?
- Building of the crematorium may influence the future provision of bus services so bus stop laybys should be provided on either side of Junction Road to serve public transport to the crematorium?

The comments from the objectors have been noted, however the principle of a crematorium in this location has already been accepted and comments in relation to the traffic movements have been addressed.

The comments in relation to signage at the pedestrian crossings are noted, and have been passed to the Highways Team for consideration.

In terms of the bus services, it is acknowledged that there are no services currently serving this area of Junction Road. However, both the 37 (half hourly) and 15 (every 10mins) have stops close by to the south of Junction Road. SBC is not currently aware of a desire from operators to serve the crematorium directly, however if they were to do so it is considered that stop provision could be provided on Junction Road without laybys, as is the case on the length of Junction Road that is served to the east of The Glebe.

In relation to the potential for dust a Construction Management Plan has been conditioned to ensure that any disturbance in minimised.

## **CONCLUSION AND RECOMMENDATION**

The recommendation of the main report remains unchanged, which is that the application be approved with conditions and the additional condition in relation to archaeology is applied.
