

DAILY ROUTINE FOR THE DOGS

This is our general daily management plan for the dogs, all dogs are checked over/ handled at each interval.

ROTATIONS ARE IN THE FOLLOWING GROUPS :

- 1) EVA & STORM BETWEEN THE RUNS
- 2) PEACHES, PURDY & EZRA BETWEEN THE RUNS
- 3) DOTTIE BINKY BETSY & ROWIE BETWEEN THE THREE RUNS
- 4) KITTY, KATE & ROMBA BETWEEN THE THREE RUNS
- 5) LETTIE & GRACIE (IN A RUN) PETRA & ETTA (IN A RUN)

The dogs rest/sleep either in small groups together depending on their compatibility and size (must meet criteria of cubicles 2.85x2.85) or on their own as follows:

CUBICLES

- 1) EVA & STORM
- 2) GRACIE & LETTIE
- 3) DOTTIE, BINKY
- 4) PETRA & ETTA
- 5) PURDY, EZRA, PEACHES
- 6) KITTY, KATE & ROMBA
- 7) BETSY & ROWIE

8am - Dogs out for toilet in main dog yard in group rotation as above for 10 minutes each group. There is a member of staff in the outbuilding with the dogs that aren't out at the time. When they're all back in any poo's are picked up. Kong's are given to each dog stuffed with biscuits or tinned dog food/kong spray.

10am -Dogs out for toilet and exercise in main dog yard/exercise area in group rotation of 20 minutes each group. While a staff member is in the outbuilding preparing their food and cleaning up the pods, bowls, toys, floors and changing bedding etc. We also use this time with the dogs both inside and outside for training/playing. Dogs are fed their first feed. When they're back in any poo is picked up and the yards are washed down.

4pm - Dogs out for toilet and exercise in the main dog yard/exercise area in group rotation of 20 minutes each. While a member of staff is in the outbuilding preparing their food and cleaning up pods, bowls, toys, floors and changing bedding etc. I also use this time with the dogs both inside and outside for training/playing. Dogs are fed their second feed. When all the dogs are back in the yards get washed down.

7pm - Dogs out for toilet in main dog yard in group rotation of 10 minutes each group. A member of staff is in the outbuilding with the dogs that aren't out at the time. When they're back in any poo is picked up.

There is always a member of staff present when the dogs are out, we would never leave dogs out and go out anywhere as it's a security risk with dog thefts. Our dogs are amongst the elite within their specific breed we have many show champions under our affix Chamelia. We take pride in the fact that we are highly regarded within our breeds for health, temperament and stunning dogs. This is not just an income for our family and the families of the ladies that work for us its been my life long passion and no expense or love is spared when it comes to our dogs. They are our top priority with regards care, welfare and security. Therefore there is always a staff member around to supervise them be it outside in the run with them or in the outbuilding. We have a baby monitor system and state of the art cctv system with audio set up in the outbuilding for when the dogs are in so we can monitor them at anytime whether that be during the night or when we are out.

The room temperature in the dog room is monitored via the baby monitor MIN 10c Max 26c.

There are dog health recording sheets available in the 'DOG FOLDER' situated in the outbuilding should a dog be witnessed to be ill, change in behaviour, stressed, anxious or any change in toilet or eating/drink habits.

Our cubicles are of a size and layout that the dogs can be changed around should we feel its necessary and to accommodate whelping bitches.

We have four members of staff in total caring for the dogs 365 day a year. Two of the staff are employed by us and myself and my husband are on hand most of the time.
