## RECORDED CRIME \& DISORDER UPDATE

This report sets out the recorded crime figures for April 2007 - September 2007 compared with April 2006- September 2006. The report also shows recorded Anti Social Behaviour Disorder codes. The disorder comparisons were not possible in 2006/07 due to changes in recording, but can be reinstated for 2007/08 using 2006/07 as the baseline year.
