1.	<u>Jill Dando Institute – feedback on Partnership Strategic Assessment</u> Considered feedback, agreed to add to SSP agenda.	MB
2.	<u>Reducing Re-offending</u>	
(a)	Hartlepool Model Discussed options for similar set-up in Stockton. To be considered by DIP/PPO Strategy Group on 23 July. Would require some re-direction of resources.	
(b)	Local Reducing Re-offending Plan Considered first draft proposals for a way forward. MB to re-draft, taking into account discussion (including proposal for a seminar on 10 October to 'kick start'), and include on SSP agenda.	MB
3.	<u>First time Entrants to the Youth Justice System (NI 111) / OBTJ and Sanction detections</u> Discussed background, including Home Office view that Sanction Detections and OBTJ are now history, and Judith Million's commitment to discuss this with ACPO from the three regional forces. If this view is accepted, then we'd need willingness on the part of Government to classify alternative disposals (e.g. referral to YOS preventions team) as a 'sanction'. Would need a Cleveland Police wide decision.
