NI15 Most Serious Violent Crime

There have been **78** MSV crimes between April 2008 to February 2009 (0.42 per 1,000 population), which is an increase of 5 offences on the same period last year. Figures have been reclassified since the last report and a full breakdown of MSV offences per quarter are provided below.
