1.	<p>High Crime Causers</p> <p>Discussed context for police staffing. Current Billingham Inspector retires in November, role to be combined with current Neighbourhood Safety Inspector role, which will no longer have responsibility for child protection, domestic violence, or vulnerable adults, all of which are going into the new Vulnerable Persons (VP) Unit (joint with Hartlepool). Unclear at present how many police constables will be taken to VP Unit, Air Support Unit, Sentry Vehicle (armed Counter Terrorism patrol) and proposed Central Planning Unit for major events, so second police officer for High Crime Causers Team is currently unlikely, but not definitely ruled out, depends on how these issues are resolved.</p>	
2.	<p>Data Recording</p> <p>Discussed issues around gap analysis arising from Partnership Strategic Assessment. Capture of all data on crimes is a long standing problem relating to time pressure on and skills of police officers. Ultimate answer may be a technical solution based on downloading from Personal Data Terminals. DCI Derek Carter is leading on these issues.</p>
