

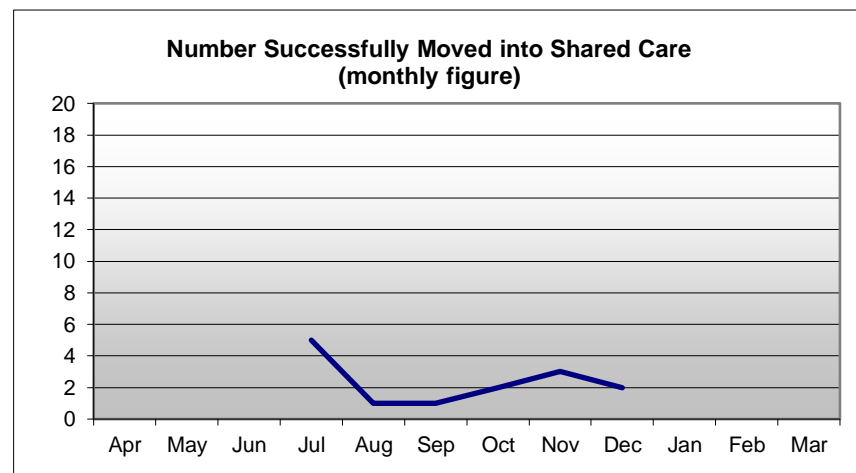
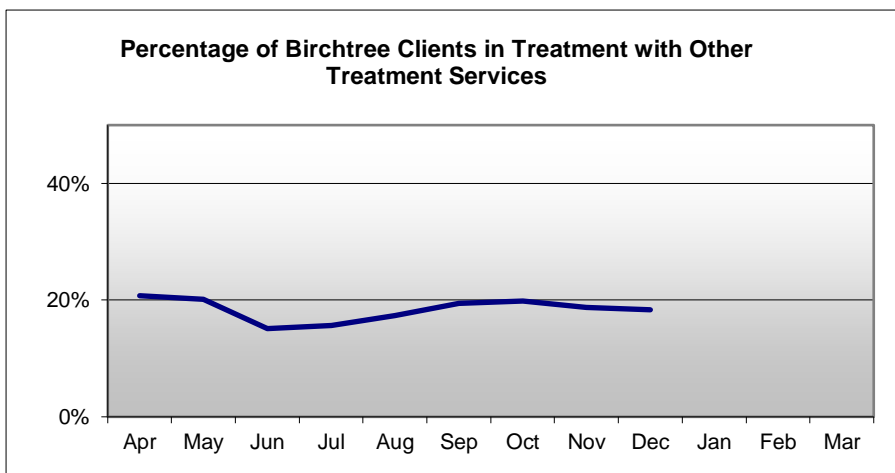
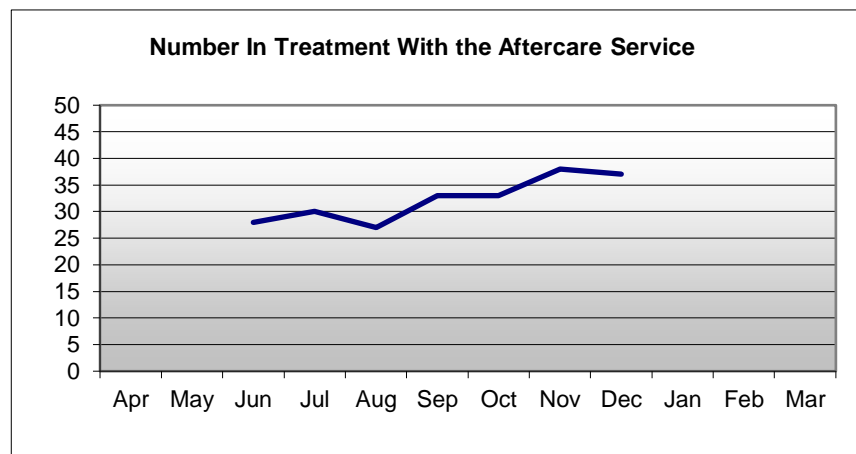
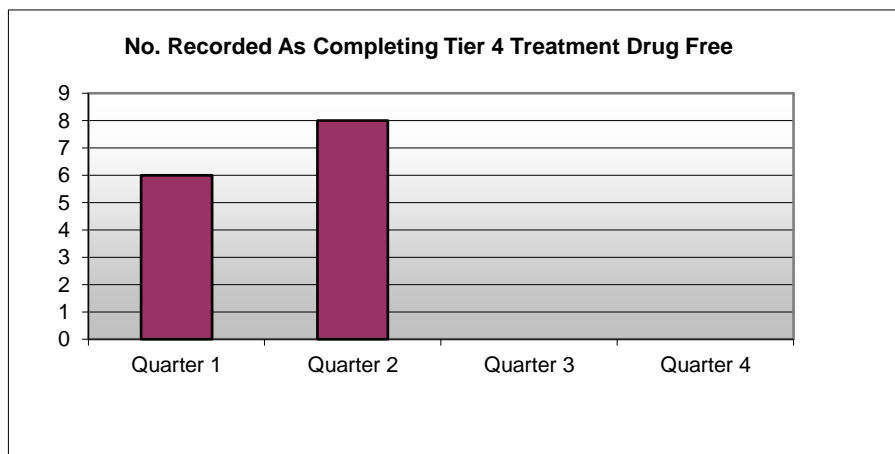
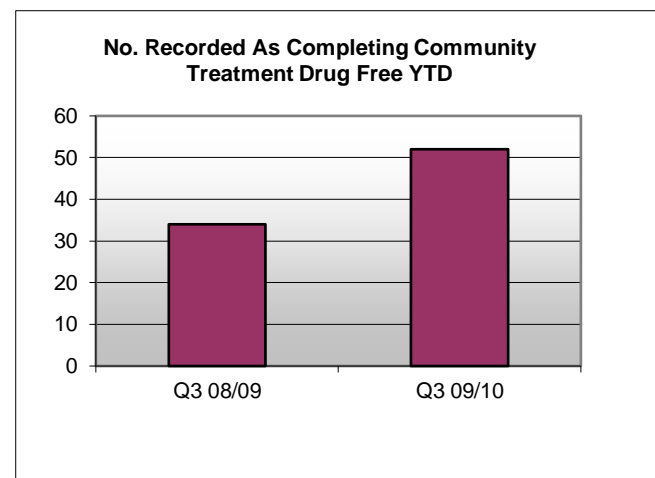
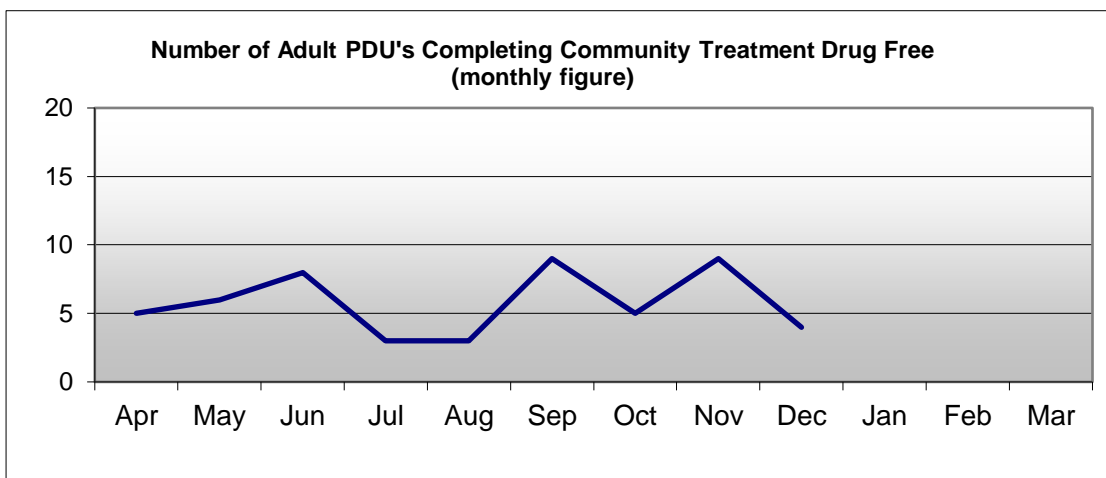
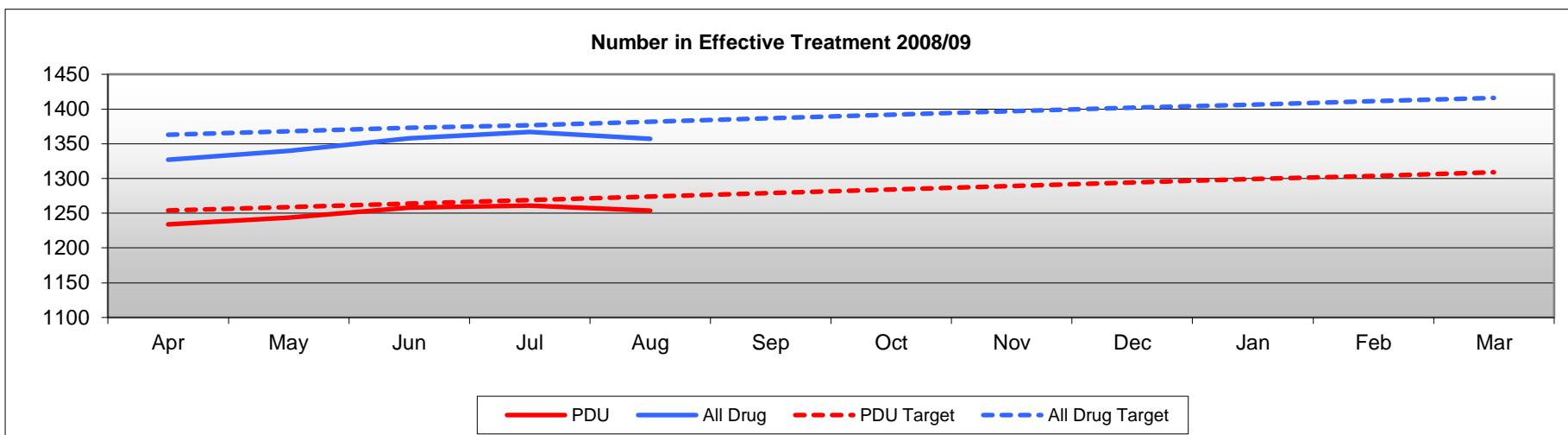
During Quarters 2/3 a lot of activity has been underway to raise awareness around the new treatment system, and to embed new ways of working. This has included the Treatment System Launch Event in September, work to build relationships with wider organisations and services, further work on treatment pathways, and the development of the new Treatment Service Directory.

The performance statistics show a varied picture. On some priority areas there has been clear progress, however on other priorities more is still to be done to achieve the desired outcomes. For example whilst increasing numbers appear to be completing drug free from community and tier 4, and increasing numbers are accessing the Aftercare service, numbers in treatment aren't increasing in line with target requirements. All involved agencies are working hard to look at new ways of working together to engage more individuals in treatment to try and ensure the challenging end of year targets are met.

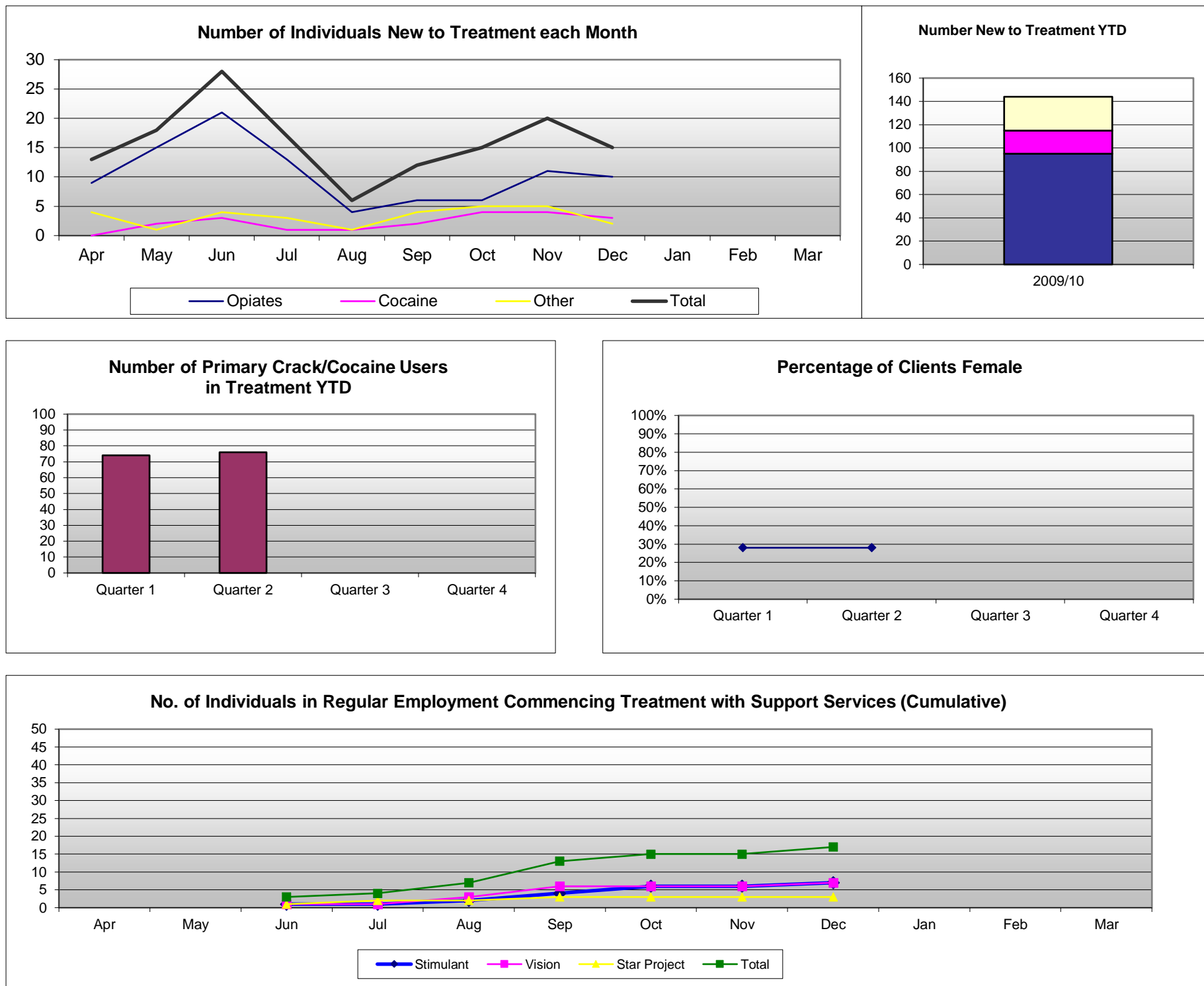
Numbers of Birchtree clients accessing other services remains relatively low, although there were small improvements from June. Further work is also needed around increasing access to Shared Care. There have been good levels of recording around housing and parental issues, however recent surveys and the needs assessment show that these remain important issues.

Services have now been provided with training to enable them to do Brief Interventions around Alcohol. This appears to have been successful with numbers of Alcohol AUDIT questionnaires completed increasing. However activity across services is varied.

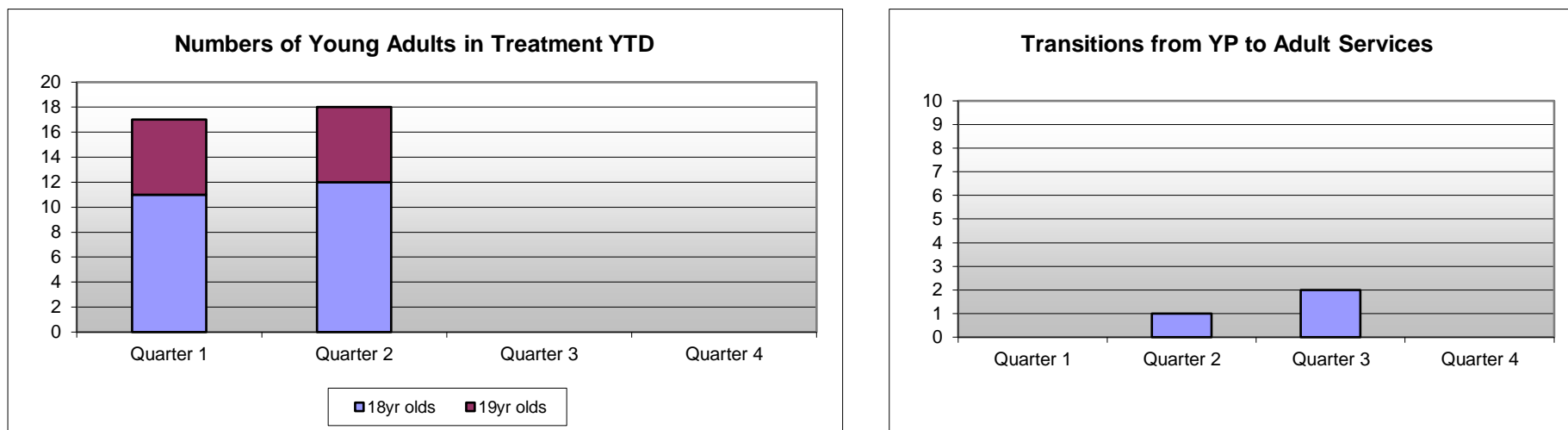
