

hi Ed,

as part of my work with cleveland police I sit on the committee that organises art of safety each year. Originally this was the idea of the Chief Constable Sean price and over the past three years it has grown into the major police-youth engagement initiative across Cleveland.

we have decided this year to open it up to the four safety partnerships as part of the joint working drive, to help with costs in these tight times and also because it was felt an ideal project for joint working given the aims of the police and the safety partnerships. The ACPO lead on art of safety, ACO Ann Hall, has asked me to contact the local safety partnerships.

I havn't approached the childrens trust or anyone else for funding as time is pressing and we want to keep it quite tight but that is soemthign we could consider in the future. Last year we were given some support from the charity arm of CapGemini and they may renew again.
