1.	<p><b><u>SSP Agenda 29 March</u></b></p> <p>PCSOs - Chief Constable has indicated that there may be a re-distribution over time, as natural wastage takes place.            There is a threshold below which CPA would lose HO funding.            Model exists for 46.5 for Stockton – reductions on the Wards with larger NPTs, and reflecting current actuals – no recent changes.            CI Mick Williams attending meeting on Institute for Local Governance on 31 March.</p>	
2.	<p><b><u>2012/13 Funding</u></b></p> <p>Discussed possible options around continued use of the reduced funding, particularly IOM and Domestic Violence.            Provision for police overtime would be very helpful.            Costs of major covert drug operations start at £25k</p>	
3.	<p><b><u>Police &amp; Crime Commissioner</u></b></p> <p>Police Reform &amp; Social Responsibility Bill due to be enacted in May.            Some suggestion that remit may be extended into offender management.</p>
