  - Free from drug(s) of dependence
  - Offending (reduced)
  - Employment
  - Health & Wellbeing
    - Injecting
    - Housing
    - Vaccinations

The Partnership will be given a presentation on drug treatment by Emma Champley, Strategic Commissioner, Drugs, Prison Healthcare & Social Inclusion, and an update on enforcement activity by Rob Donaghy, Detective Chief Inspector.
