Drug Treatment – Payment by Results

On 3 August 2011 a consultation regarding Payment by Results in Drug Treatment closed. The consultation document was minimal and can be found at http://www.nta.nhs.uk/healthcare-pbr.aspx

The Safer Stockton Partnership discussed the proposed payment model at a recent meeting, responding to the consultation as per the attached document. The Partnership noted the consultation was not regarding whether Payment by Results should occur, but how Payment by Results should be nationally applied.

You will see from the attached that the Partnership has significant concerns with the proposals identified in the consultation.

The Partnership wanted its concerns to be expressed to you. It also wished to affirm that, although it supports payment by results being identified and incorporated into individual contracts locally, it does not support an over-arching payment by results system that has the potential to fragment current positive operational partnership working.

Please accept this correspondence as an expression of the Safer Stockton Partnership's deep concern at the potential harm to localities that could occur if the proposed Payment by Results system is not significantly amended.

Thank you for writing to me about the introduction of 'payment by results' strategies being proposed for drug treatment regimes.

I am pleased that your letter confirms your acceptance that the concept of payment by results has a place in driving up standards and increasing accountability. We may well, however, be at odds about the extent to which this radical proposal is capable of being successfully implemented.

The area in which you are involved is not alone in being required to consider more stringent measures of success. Recidivism in released prisoners, for example, may also be a key criterion for payment to service providers.

I enjoyed the provocative detail of your submission. I intend to forward it to the appropriate ministry for inclusion in the nationwide debate which the government is encouraging.
