## Summary of Home Office Drug Treatment Funding to transfer to the Police & Crime Commissioner

Total Amount of Annual Funding: £224,048

Of this amount £170,563 contributes to the Drug & Alcohol Arrest Referral Service based in the Custody Suite, Middlesbrough. This is currently a contract held by Cleveland Police and it is proposed that responsibility for this contract transfers to the PCC.

The remaining £53,485 does not fund one individual service, it contributes to the Counted4 contract for Birchtree and the CRI service that individuals from the Arrest Referral service are referred into. The CRI service is due to be re-tendered in 13/14 so a budget re-profile will need to occur should the PCC indicate discontinued investment.
