## **The Community Safety Consultation 2013**

- 1.1 Attached at Appendix 1 is a working copy of the information document we are preparing that will form the basis of the Community Safety Magazine which will be going out to all residents at the end of August 2013.
- 1.2 Members of the SSP are requested to note in particular the crime and ASB statistics that we plan to use as part of the document as well as the first draft of the questionnaire for residents to complete which is attached at appendix 2.
- 1.3 Overall the figures are encouraging and there has been some significant progress in the last three years which will be good to highlight to residents. In addition to this we plan to highlight some of the challenges that the partnership is facing to provide residents with a realistic and balanced status of crime and ASB in Stockton.
- 1.4 Following the appointment of the Police and Crime Commissioner we have made reference to his priorities within the body of the questionnaire to gauge resident opinion as well as ensure consistency both in terms of the consultation and the subsequent revision of the Community Safety Strategy and Action Plans.

It is **RECOMMENDED** that the Safer Stockton Partnership acknowledge the progress to date and advise of any changes of suggestions to be included in future drafts.
