The above table lists wards within Stockton Borough in relation to crime ranking compared to deprivation.

What the above information tells us is that of the 26 wards, there are three that are significantly better for crime compared to their deprivation ranking, followed by 19 wards in line with deprivation. These 22 wards equate to 85% of the Borough area.

Only four wards, Norton North, Norton West, Yarm and Northern Parishes were worse than their ranking for deprivation. However crime within all but three of these wards remains lower than average when looking at crime rate per 1000 population and only accounts for 12% of all crime within the Borough.

Crime within these wards is also varied dependent upon the ward with theft offences, in particular shoplifting featuring within Norton North and night time associated violence linked to Yarm. Norton North has also been subjected to spates of crime varying from criminal damage to thefts which has added to overall crime levels.
