AT THIS TIME , I REGULARLY HAVE FOOD BOXES & BOTTLES DROPPED OVER THE WALL , PEOPLE URINATING BY MY DRIVEWAY G.T.C. THE STREET IS NOT WELL LIT SO IT BECOMES THE FIRST CONVENIENT 'DARK CORNER'. IT WOULD HAVE A SIGNIFICANT IMPACT ON MY FAMILY HOME IF THIS WERE TO BECOME THE NORM.



On the evening of 24th October 2016 I found 2 men urinating in the arch way of Lord Nelson's Yard and both of these displayed confrontational behaviour when I objected to this. Both of these men returned to the pizza shop. Since then similar incidents have occurred. There is a concern as to who will 'police' the area at 12.00? Most pubs are coming out at 23.00-24.00, many people could be drunk and this could cause further problems of anti-social behaviour that is dangerous so near to residential dwellings such as Lord Nelson's Yard and Hauxwell's Yard. Making it unsafe for me and other residents living in the yards to return or leave our homes.

On a Friday evening there is weekly gathering of youngsters who have started to use the archway as a latrine, further problems have occurred due to them sitting on shop steps and standing in doorways and this is rather unnerving for older people passing by and living near due to 'gang culture. There is the problem of litter due to pizza boxes and discarded food being thrown over the gate in both Hauxwell's yard and frontage of Lord Nelson's Yard. I am concerned that this will escalate and attract undesirable vermin if the premises open until 12.00. The pizza shop has not provided any bin for customers to place their litter in

There are several eateries in Yarm selling food to take out and this could create a precedent for others to open causing more disturbances in the nearby area.





##### Prevention of Crime and Disorder

Selling late night alcohol so close to the entrances of enclosed residential areas is likely to further fuel existing levels of antisocial behaviour and frighten residents, many of them elderly, whilst effectively trapping them in their homes.

##### Prevention of Public Nuisance


The Entrance to Lord Nelsons Yard as well as being the only entry and exit to residents' homes , provides shelter and dark spaces ; as such the walls are frequently used for public urination, and on occasions defecation, and there is regular vomit, cigarette butts and broken glass littering the entrance . (see photos). If a licence were granted for late night alcohol so close to the residents' entrance the existing problems could be expected to multiply exacerbating the public nuisance still further. (Neither the council nor clubs clean this up, nor light the entrance , nor sign the entrance, nor provide cctv)

Encouraging and facilitating people (many of whom may already have been drinking for a prolonged time) to loiter for an hour and continue their drinking in such close proximity to residential areas is likely to exacerbate the existing public nuisance that residents experience. The granting of a licence for this time would aggravate and increase that nuisance at a time when residents might reasonably be anticipated to be sleeping.

##### Public Safety

The entrance to Lord Nelsons Yard is the residents only entrance and exit route to and from their homes. Encouraging inebriated individuals and gangs armed with more alcohol and glass bottles to loiter at the entrance to resident's homes might reasonably be considered unsafe.

I am concerned the volume of cigarette butts thrown down in a sheltered indent inside the entrance is a fire hazard to residents, one that might be expected to increase with more people likely to be lingering late at night if a licence was granted – this being the closest area to shelter in.

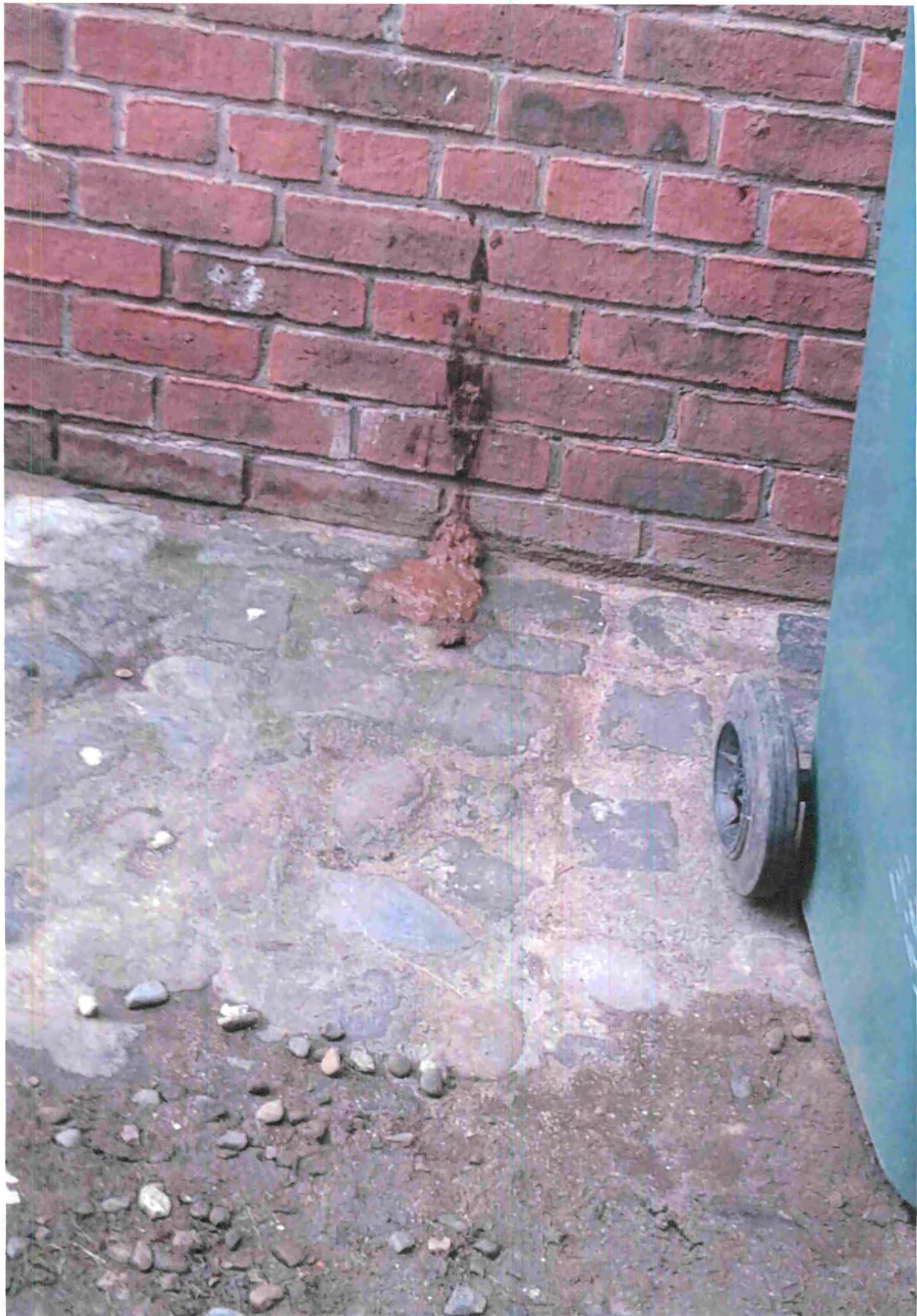
