To promote all four licensing objectives we will ensure management controls and effective training all staff so that they are aware of the premises license and the requirements to meet the licensing objectives with particular attention to: - no selling of alcohol to underage people
- zero tolerance to drunk and disorderly behavior on the premises area
- zero tolerance to violent or any anti- social behavior
- operating schedule providing the hours of operation and licensable activities during those hours. - Designated premises supervisor/ team leaders to ensure day-to-day controls of the premises, to provide good training for
staff on the licensing act, to make or authorize each sale Clear "Challange 25" information to prevent the supply of alcohol to under-age drinkers.
- CCTV system installed with recording option available.
As a licensed premises we know that is necessary to carry out our functions or operate their businesses with a purpose of promoting these objectives. we promise to support these objectives through their operating schedules and other measures.
b) The prevention of crime and disorder
CCTV system installed to encourage the prevention of crime to the premises and the surrounding areas.
Not selling alcohol to drunk or intoxicated customers. Alcohol will only be served to customers for consumption during the special evening events scheduled through out the year, and not during the retail hours of the butchers shop (7.00am - 17.30pm mon - Sat)
Staff will be trained in asking customers to use the premises in an orderly & respectful manner.

c) Public safety

internal lighting to promote the public safety & fire exits

well trained staff adherence to environmental health requirements training & implementation of underage ID checks. all utilities will be well maintained at all times and ensured all are safe condition & in good working order.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

without the specific permission of the relevant licensing authority, there shall be no sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises

Any music played within the premises shall be at background level only and shall not cause a noise disturbance at the adjacent residential properties.

Prominent, clear and legible notices will be displayed at the exit requesting the public to respect the needs of nearby residents and to leave the premises and area quietly.

Customers will not be admitted to the premises above opening hours.

e) The protection of children from harm

"Challage 25" sign which is a retail strategy that encourages anyone who is over 18 but looks under 25 to carry acceptable ID (a photographic driving license or a passport) if they wish to buy alcohol. well trained staff requirement for persons identification, age establishment.
