Annex 1 – Mandatory Conditions

MANDATORY CONDITIONS

1 No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence:

(a) at any time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or(b) at any time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or his personal licence is suspended.

- 2 Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.
- 3 Any alcohol supplied for consumption off the premises must be in a sealed container.
- 4 (1) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(2) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

Annex 2 – Conditions Consistent With The Operating Schedule

PREVENTION OF PUBLIC NUISANCE

- 1 Without the specific permission of the relevant Licensing Authority there shall be no sale of alcohol for consumption on the premises.
- 2 There shall be no more than 24 events at which licensable activities take place in any one calendar year.
- 3 Live music should be available only for the purposes of Christmas carol singers leading up to Christmas.
- 4 Any music played within the premises shall be at background level only and shall not cause a noise disturbance at the adjacent residential properties.

PROTECTION OF CHILDREN FROM HARM

- 1 A "Challenge 21" policy will be implemented with all staff insisting on evidence of age from any person appearing to be under 21 years of age and who is attempting to buy alcohol. At least one public notice shall be displayed at the point of sale to inform customers and remind staff that the premise is operating a "Challenge 21" policy.
- 2 The only acceptable evidence of age will be a valid photo identification confirming the purchaser's age, namely a passport, photo driving licence or PASS approved proof of age card such as a Validate Card, Portman Group Card or a Citizen Card.

- 3 All staff will be trained with regard to the law concerning the sale of alcohol and also the operation of the associated "Challenge 21" policy. Staff will receive refresher training at least every 6 months.
- 4 Training records, signed by both the staff member and the Designated Premise Supervisor/Store Manager/Business Owner will be retained for future reference and shall be updated at least every 6 months. All staff training records will be made available to the Licensing Authority and/or Responsible Authorities upon request.
- 5 The business will maintain a refusals book to record all instances where the sale of alcohol has been refused. This shall include the date and time of the attempted sale, together with a description of the incident. The Designated Premises Supervisor/Store Manager/Business Owner will check and sign each page and the Refusals book will be made available to the Licensing Authority and/or Responsible Authorities upon request.
- 6 There shall be at least one notice displayed on the premises at the point of sale indicating that the sale of alcohol to those under 18 is illegal and that those adults who buy alcohol for immediate disposal to those under the age of 18 are committing an offence.
