



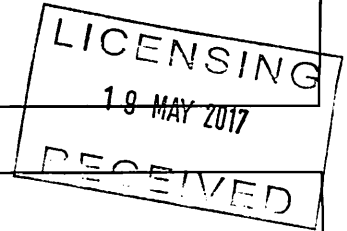

 My 2 bedrooms overlook the Green and there is parking immediately below I am concerned that Blackwells may well now be open until nearly midnight on many evenings. There will inevitably be additional noise both from customers leaving the premises, in taxis, or in cars possibly parked very close to my home. It is proposed that music noise played up till 11pm and this is likely to be additional*

disturbance as the door is opened when customers enter or leave the premises. Customers may also leave to smoke outside and this is likely to cause an additional nuisance. Clearly, the intention is to provide what is effectively a Restaurant and cooking smells could well be an issue. The Green is exclusively Residential and not a Commercial area and I hope this character can be preserved

THE GREEN (WHICH ADJOINS BLACKWELLS) IS ONE OF THE VERY FEW PARTS OF URBAN TEESIDE WHICH HAS RETAINED A RURAL CHARACTER, AND IS A PLACE OF RELATIVE PEACE AND QUIET, ESPECIALLY IN THE EVENING.

I AM CONCERNED THAT THE EXTENSION OF LICENSING HOURS WILL JEOPARDISE THIS. BLACKWELLS HAS HITHERTO BEEN OPEN FOR BUSINESS MAINLY DURING NORMAL SHOP HOURS. THE PROPOSAL TO SERVE ALCOHOL AND HAVE MUSIC UNTIL 11.00 P.M. MOST DAYS, AND UNTIL 8.00 PM ON SUNDAYS IS LIKELY TO LEAD TO THE FOLLOWING:

1. AN ADDITIONAL FOOTFALL OF PEOPLE VISITING THE PREMISES, QUITE POSSIBLY NOT LEAVING UNTIL

MIDNIGHT OR LATER

2. ADDITIONAL TRAFFIC, BOTH FROM CUSTOMERS CARS AND TAXIS CAUSING NOISE AND DISTURBANCE TO MANY PEOPLE IN A PREDOMINANTLY RESIDENTIAL AREA.
3. THE ADDITIONAL BURDEN ON ALREADY LIMITED PARKING.
4. THE LIKELIHOOD OF MUSIC AND OTHER NOISE BEING AUDIBLE OUTSIDE THE PREMISES. THIS IS INEVITABLE AS THE DOOR IS USED BY CUSTOMERS ARRIVING OR LEAVING.
5. THE PROBABLE OVERSPILL OF CUSTOMERS LEAVING THE PREMISES DURING THE COURSE OF EVENTS IN ORDER TO SMOKE. IT IS NOT UNLIKELY THAT THEY MAY TAKE THEIR DRINKS WITH THEM (POSSIBLY IN BREACH OF A BYE-LAW ALCOHOL CONTROLLED AREA). WHAT ABOUT CIGARETTE ENDS OR OTHER LITTER?
6. IF THE PREMISES ARE TO OFFER "DINING EXPERIENCES" UNTIL LATE AT NIGHT IT IS POSSIBLE THAT COOKING SMELLS WILL CAUSE A NUISANCE.


