If on nights especially weekends and bank holidays she will struggle to sleep during the day due to the noise of voices, music, drunkenness and cars/taxis. By allowing music and alcohol in and outside until 00.00 is ridiculous! By the time people finish and leave this will be looking more towards 00.30 even 0100 if waiting on lifts/taxis.

I also like how the local residents have not received any postal notification in regards to this application! I would imagine if more locals were aware you would be receiving many more objections. I only noticed this sign by having a walk tonight and it is poorly located on a white washed painted door to draw less attention! I feel this is to avoid locals noticing the application giving me the perfect assumption that Al Forno are trying to hide the proposal!

Once again this is a housing estate not a town centre where people have bought their homes and are bringing up families with young children in a nice residential area. Had I wanted to be surrounded by drunks I would have purchased a house in Middlesbrough town centre at a fraction of the cost! People are very unlikely to be turning up late at night to order a meal and AI Forno will become more of a drinking establishment rather than a family restaurant. The Myton pub closes at 2300 so AI Forno will become the next port of call to continue drinking! My concern is that the use of AI Forno will eventually be just as a bar and people won't use it for food!
