When the development was approved it was on the understanding that there would be no late night licences and take aways. Since the development has been built this has caused more problems than anyone could believe. The parking is a awful situation and is unable to accommodate the shops at present with less than half units open. I live at no.5 Bancroft Drive and can hear the workers building on the Al Fono site I dread to think how this will be until midnight. This is a built up area within a residential area which has many young families. I have 2 young children and believe this will disturb them due to the loud music, drunken behaviour, cars coming and going and potential violence and damage.

I have already had to put up CCTV on my property due to misbehaviour in the area. I have had vomit and dog fouling outside my house and on my property. If people are intoxicated this will result in further vomit and urination against my front door!

I work long days Monday to Friday having to commute and my sleep will be disturbed making me tired and a danger to drive. My wife is a nurse in A&E and work 12.5hr nights and days.

This will disturb her sleep as she has to get up at 5.30am to start work on a day shift. Less sleep will make her a danger in her job! If on nights especially weekends and bank holidays she will struggle to sleep during the day due to the noise of voices, music, drunkenness and cars/taxis. By allowing music and alcohol in and outside until 00.00 is ridiculous! By the time people finish and leave this will be looking more towards 00.30 even 0100 if waiting on lifts/taxis.

I also like how the local residents have not received any postal notification in regards to this application! I would imagine if more locals were aware you would be receiving many more objections. I only noticed this sign by having a walk tonight and it is poorly located on a white washed painted door to draw less attention! I feel this is to avoid locals noticing the application giving me the perfect assumption that Al Forno are trying to hide the proposal!

Once again this is a housing estate not a town centre where people have bought their homes and are bringing up families with young children in a nice residential area. Had I wanted to be surrounded by drunks I would have purchased a house in Middlesbrough town centre at a fraction of the cost! People are very unlikely to be turning up late at night to order a meal and Al Forno will become more of a drinking establishment rather than a family restaurant. The Myton pub closes at 2300 so Al Forno will become the next port of call to continue drinking! My concern is that the use of Al Forno will eventually be just as a bar and people won't use it for food!
