The situ of the premises is where Stockton Council have erected a pontoon type bus stop with paving to the kerb, directly outside the property making it inaccessible for deliveries directly to the door. The pavement at this particular section of the High Street is already an obstacle course of clothes rails plants and various A boards for pedestrians let alone the aged and disabled.






I won an award and represented Stockton Council labc awards in 2011 This would devastate me if this went ahead and would of course appeal.




