1. The legal requirement of advertisement of the variation application in a place where the public can read it, has not been met. No notice of the application has been posted in the area to which the application relates.

2. The proposed variation, would widen the area licensed to supply alcohol to a degree that renders it far more difficult to control, and dealing with the individual licensing objectives: -

Prevention of crime and disorder

The extent of the variation, covering a number of streets, car parks, and enclosed yards, is an unacceptable increase in the area available for alcoholic drinks to be consumed in public. This was demonstrated in the recent past when Stockton Council had to introduce measures to prevent the consumption of alcohol in the town centre because of the level of crime and disorder which resulted from drinking in the High Street, and adjoining streets and lanes.

Prevention of public nuisance

The Town Centre in recent years has seen an increase in the residential use of the premises on the High Street and in the area of this application. An increase in the licensed area as proposed would cause difficulties for access by local residents to their premises, and the same applies for local businesses in the proposed area.


Protection of children from harm

Referring to the residential accommodation in the Town Centre, many of the flats and apartments are family homes with young children, who will be exposed to alcohol being consumed in the public areas covered by the proposed variation, and the associated problems which come from excessive consumption of alcohol.

Public safety

The extension of the area makes it far more difficult to supervise and police, covering as it does not only public highways but also yards and passageways which are difficult, if not impossible, to supervise or police.

I operate a professional office from 4 Silver Street and the current levels of noise nuisance from revellers is already excessive. This can only be made much worse by the licence variation sought, which will include the whole of Silver Street as an area permitted to be used for noise and rowdy behaviour. My business hours are normally until at least 8-00 PM and often well past that time. The greater the number of revellers in the evening the more likely the possibility of broken windows and alarm trigger events (which have occurred already).

Additionally there are residential areas within Silver Street which will be adversely affected.

I only wish to restrict the benefits such an extension would bring to the current operators, by removing from the proposed variation the words "and to extend the licence to include Silver Street", I do not wish to curtail them altogether. However there can be very little present gain from including all of Silver Street as a revellers area, and if the licence was restricted to exclude Silver Street there would be no effect on the remaining areas as access can be maintained along Silver Street merely the Street can not become a venue for Street "music" vending etc. This would also allow the revellers to access the licenced areas easily and quickly without congregating in Silver Street.
