I object to the sale of alcohol in the premises from the above time stated, as there have been many instances of antisocial behaviour in my street and indeed locality, over the year and a half I have resided in my property, many of the instances were triggered by use of alcohol. As my house is situated in the corner of St Paul's Terrace with open access for pedestrians, it has been observed that drinkers have been noisy late at night, throwing cans around, and causing nuisance and disturbance to myself and other residents. In addition, many young people and children in the area were presented with antisocial behaviour for which the police and Enforcement Services have been informed and tried to deal with the incidents.

Specifically, some of the crimes recently related to: This year March/April ? 2017 residents at no 1, (Asylum seekers) were attacked twice (racial attack) and most windows were broken. Reported to the police and Enforcement Team.

16th December 2017 8.00 pm group of children kept knocking on people's doors, including mine and Enforcement was called.  
25th November 2017 a young child threw a stone/branch towards my side window in St Paul's Street.

22nd November I witnessed a suspected drug dealing incident from my back study window at 12.30 pm, whereas a motorbike drove through to St Paul's Terrace and a plastic envelope was exchanged between two men waiting down the lane. Not reported to the police.

14th November 2017- A car was vandalised in the car park of the premises above in broad daylight with five witnesses present, from St Paul's Court. Two men used a hammer and stole money and wallet from the bonnet. I reported the incident as the car belonged to the asylum seeker's friend but I was told that he needs to report it himself which he refused to do.

12th November 2017- ASB- Youth knocked loudly on my door, run away down St Paul's Terrace. Also a window was broken at no 22 Vicarage Road property by suspected youths, it was reported to the police.

9th November 2017- Gang of youths banged loudly at my door and stole my door bell from outside. Reported to the police, incident was investigated.

2-3 November 2017- Gang of 5-6 youths gathered around my property, Enforcement were called, and on the 3rd November a drunk youth argued with his girlfriend and banged his head against my wall and stole the water pipe from the Asylum seeker's house at no 1, St Paul's Terrace. I reported it to the police, but unable to proceed further as they did not report this incident themselves.

5th November 2017- Two young boys stole a door bell from no 2 St Paul's Road and threw it at my window shouting: "have you got your bell, did you get your bell! Incident was reported to the police and Enforcement.

There have been other incidents related to drink and antisocial behaviour in my area and vicinity of my property and I am worried that sale of alcohol to youths and children

will encourage more antisocial behaviour in the area, detrimental to my mental and psychological well-being and quality of life.

As there is no fence or alleygate to protect my property and neighbouring property from ASBOS, sale of alcohol will result in increase of crime and drug and alcohol related offenses, which will seriously affect the quality of life in my area.


Litter related to drinks has frequently been collected by myself in the past and the Care for Your Area Team.

Consultation is needed to determine whether sale of alcohol is detrimental to the local community. Many residents are witnessed to carry large boxes of lager and spirit over the weekends.

Drunk residents <sup>were</sup> ~~are~~ observed to disturb my sleep as they are very noisy during the night.

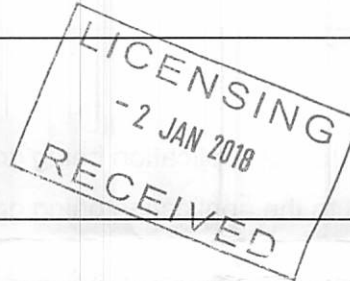
