Cleveland Police make an application to review this premises licence for the following reasons:

On October 10th 2017 a hearing was held at Stockton Town Hall in regards to the transfer of the premises licence to Eric Hill.

Cleveland Police made representations in respect of this transfer due to evidence of a 'stopyy back' as well as breaches of the premises licence; however the committee were minded to grant this application.

Since then there have been several incidents of crime and disorder at the premises culminating on the 12th November at 4.30am when a female suffered an assault following a 'stopyy back' at the pub.

What makes this incident worse is that this is not the first time such activity has taken place but on this occasion a CCTV camera has been deliberately turned to face the ceiling so as not to cover the area where the 'stopyy back' has happened.

The CCTV was requested and a memory stick was provided but there was nothing recorded on this device and when a further visit was made to the premises to get the footage again, the images had 'dropped off' the system as it was only recording for 10 days and not the 31 days as the premises licence conditions state.

In light of this Cleveland Police feel there is no alternative but to seek a review of the premises licence.




If a premise is having problems I would advise on a course of action and would work with the licensee/DPS to help prevent and reduce any issues raised.

Manhattans is a licensed premise situated at 9 High Street, Stockton which is at the Northern end of the High Street near to the Parish Church and the site of the proposed Globe Theatre.

Manhattans currently has a licence to sell alcohol for consumption on and off the premises between 09:00 – 01:00hrs Sunday to Thursday and 09:00 – 02:00hrs Friday and Saturday with the premises closing at the same time.

This review has been brought by Cleveland Police due to incidents at the premises which Police believe have undermined the licensing objectives.

This premises Licence was recently transferred to Eric Hill to which Cleveland Police made representations and a hearing was held at Stockton Town Hall on the 10th October 2017.

I have attached my original statement dated 29th September 2017, in respect of this hearing which I exhibit as JRJ/1

Following this hearing the licensing committee granted the transfer of the premises licence to Mr Hill despite the objections from Cleveland Police.


I have attached the decision letter from this hearing dated 16th October 2017, which I exhibit as JRJ/2.

In compiling the evidence for this review I have looked at Police systems to provide an overview of occurrences at the premises along with visits I have made to the premises itself.

At 5.06pm on Tuesday 10th October 2017 a call was made from the premises regarding a male and female causing problems inside the premises.

As a result of this, both the male and female were arrested.

Event E183793 refers and I exhibit this event as JRJ/3.

At 5.25pm on Sunday 15th October 2017 a call was made to police from a female who alleged she had been assaulted at the premises on the 3rd October.

The allegation was that the victim was pushed to the ground suffering a broken hip.

Event E187475 refers and I exhibit this as JRJ/4.

At 1pm on Friday 20th October 2017 I was on duty in company with Polly Edwards from Stockton council when we attended the premises in order to hand the decision letter from the recent hearing to the new Premises Licence holder Eric Hill.

Also present was the DPS Lisa McParland.

He was handed a copy of the premises licence and advised that should he have any problems he should contact me.

Mr Hill showed me the new CCTV system which was installed 2 days prior to our visit so there was only a small amount of footage recorded.

At 12.03am on Wednesday 8th November 2017 a call was made to Police from the DPS about a male who was assaulted inside the pub.


The victim had allegedly suffered a nose injury however he failed to remain at the scene before Police arrived.

Event E203662 refers and I exhibit this as JRJ/5.

At 1.11pm the same day a call was made to Police from a male who alleged he was 'violently assaulted' by another male in the premises the previous evening. Crime details have been taken and an investigation has commenced.

Event E203895 refers and I exhibit this as JRJ/6.

I believe that the above 2 events are the same incident.

At 1.40pm on Friday 10th November 2017 I was on duty in company with Pc1237 Craig when we attended the premises where we spoke to Mr Hill.

The reason for the visit was to check the CCTV cameras following my visit on the 20th October.

There should have been at least 21 days of footage recorded on the CCTV system but on checking the system it was only recording back to the 31st October so it only stored 10 days of footage.

Mr Hill was advised that he needs to get the CCTV fixed so that it records for the full 31 days as per the premises licence.

At 10.56am on Sunday 12th November 2017 a call was made to Police from a female who alleged she had been assaulted inside the premises approximately 4.45am that day.

The victim said she was out drinking and there was a 'lock in' at the premises.


This female alleged that the male suspect had thrown a mobile phone at her causing a cut to the left side of her head.

Event E206360 refers and I exhibit this as JRJ/7.

I received an e-mail from Pc2290 Prudhoe in relation to the above where he states that he has attended Manhattans to check the CCTV only to find that the camera which would look onto the area where the female was assaulted was moved so it was only recording images of the ceiling.

I exhibit this e-mail as JRJ/8.

I have also attached a copy of the statement of the victim in which she states she was in the premises at 4.30am when she was assaulted.

I exhibit this statement as JRJ/9.

At 2.15pm on Friday 17th November 2017 I was on duty in company with Craig Barnes from Stockton Council when we attended Manhattans in relation to the 'stoppy back'

Neither Eric Hill nor the DPS Lisa McParland were present so we spoke to a staff member, Malcolm Connor, who showed us the footage from the night.

At 2.18am on the 12th November the camera was looking onto the VIP area where the assault took place.

At this time there were several persons sat in this area but then the CCTV camera is moved in such a way that it is pointing directly at the ceiling.


The CCTV camera is situated on the wall of the premises and is approximately 8-9 foot off the ground so there is no way that it could be knocked accidentally and even if it was it would not have moved to such an extent that the camera was pointing at the ceiling.

This camera was deliberately moved to hide the activities taking place after the permitted hours.

I asked to look at other cameras situated in the premises and was shown the footage from the camera above the bar which showed Mr Hill at the till at 4.30am and other persons both leaving and coming back into the pub at this time.

Mr Hill and the DPS arrived however on Mrs McParland came over to talk to us.

I explained what we had just seen on the CCTV and said that she was to download the footage from the camera pointing at the ceiling as well as the camera above the bar from 2am – 5am on this night.

As we left the premises I noticed that Mr Hill was stood talking to some males in the raised up area at the front of the pub and he made no attempt to come over and speak to us.

At 1.15pm on Wednesday 22nd November 2017 I was on duty when I attended the premises where I picked up a memory stick of the footage from the DPS.

At 9.15am on Thursday 23rd November 2017 I was on duty when I went to look at the footage from the CCTV.

On inserting the memory stick into the view station at Middlesbrough Police office, the display said there was no data recorded.

I asked a colleague to check and confirm this which he did.

I then called the DPS to advise her of this and she said that Mr Connor would be at the premises at 11.30am if I wanted to return to see why the footage was not recorded.


At 11.40am I attended Manhattans and spoke to Mr Connor.

He said he had burnt the footage at the weekend as he had checked it and it had recorded it onto the memory stick.

I advised him that there was nothing on the memory stick when I checked it and he confirmed that there were indeed no images recorded on the memory stick.

He seemed genuinely surprised that the footage he claimed he had downloaded was not on the memory stick.

I asked him to download the footage again but when he went onto the CCTV system it was only recording for 10 days so all the footage from the 12th November had 'dropped off'.

I asked him to check the 12th just in case but there was no data recorded.

I have obtained footage from the CCTV camera belonging to Stockton Council that looks onto Manhattans.

This shows a Range Rover vehicle pull up outside the premises and a male gets out of the drivers door who I believe is the premises licence holder Eric Hill as I know he owns a car like this.

He enters the premises and for the next hour people are seen entering the premises

Mr Hill is later seen getting back into his vehicle with other persons before driving off.

Other persons are seen outside the front of the premises before they go back in before the footage ends.


The footage from the CCTV camera is available to view and I exhibit this as JRJ/10.

Cleveland Police are of the opinion that a review of the premises licence must occur due to the activities at Manhattans.

The licence transfer only took place just over 1 month ago and part of the Police objections during the hearing was because of after hours drinking at the premises.

The problems with the CCTV were well documented at this time and following the grant of the licence the PL holder advised me that he has a new CCTV system installed however during the time since the committee hearing on the 10th October the CCTV system has not recorded for any longer than 10 days until I visited the premises at 7.35pm on Thursday the




30th November 2017 when I attended in company with Pc1237 Craig and Polly Edwards from Stockton council.

I spoke to the DPS at this time who showed me that the footage was being recorded from the 15th November.

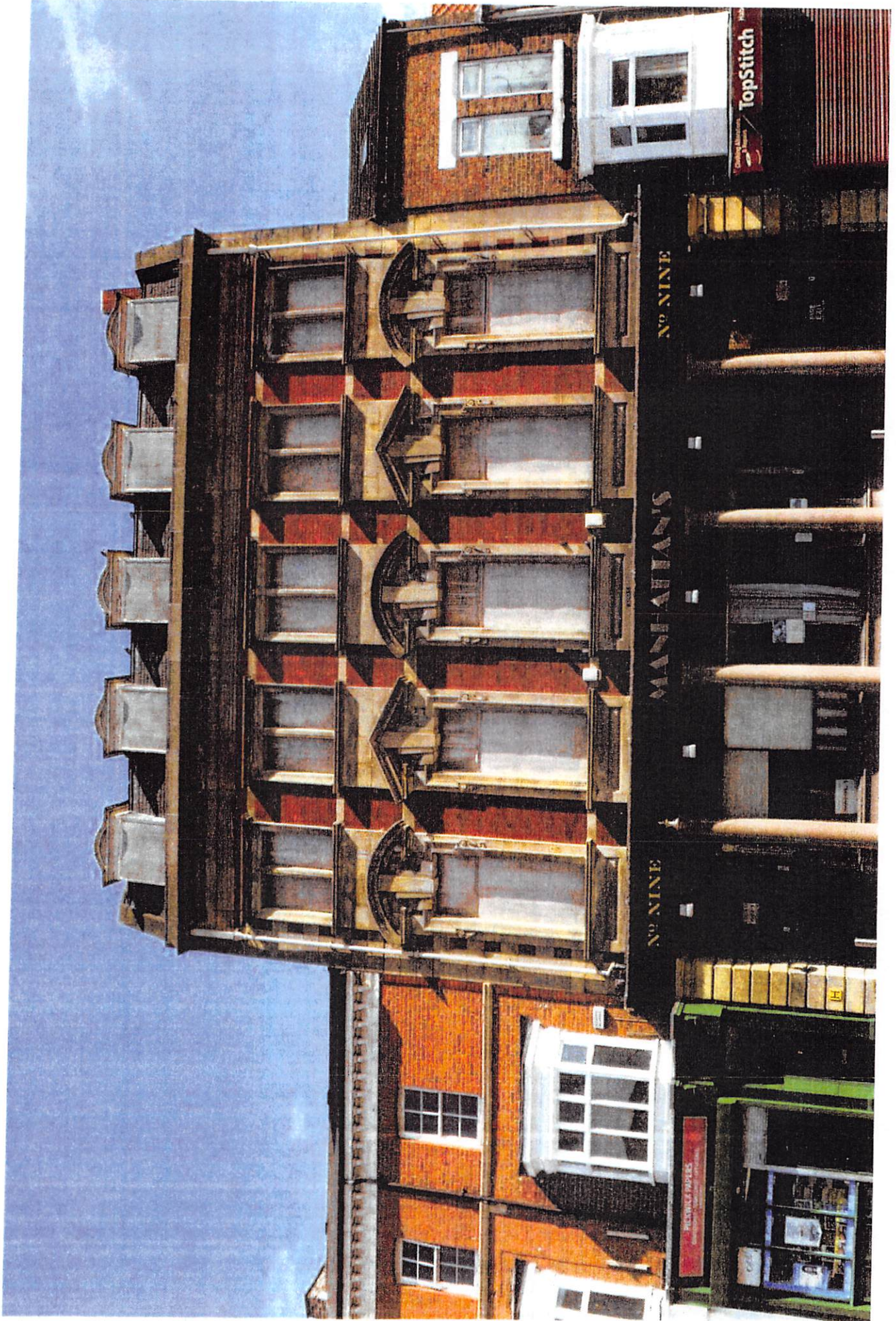

I am a police constable in the Cleveland police presently posted to the licensing support unit based at Middlesbrough Police station.

I have been in this department for over 9 years and part of my duties includes the monitoring of licensed premises. It is my responsibility to ensure that licensed premises including pubs, clubs, restaurants, takeaways and off licenses are ran safely and efficiently, and to monitor the crime and disorder that occurs at these premises.

If a premises is having problems I would advise on a course of action to rectify the situation and work with the licensee/DPS to help prevent/ reduce crime and disorder.

I am also involved with pub watch in an advisory capacity which is held every 3 months. This is a meeting where licensees, police, council and other guest speakers are brought together to discuss issues relevant to the licensing trade.

Manhattans is a public house situated at 9 High Street, Stockton which by its very location has been designated a 'hotspot' area by Cleveland Police due to the high number of licensed venues which include on and off licensed premises as well as premises undertaking Late Night Refreshment (LNR).

This part of Stockton does suffer from numerous incidents of crime and disorder due to the number of persons attending this location especially on a weekend.

The current premises licence holder is a John Taylor who has been in this position since the licence was granted in April 2016.

The sale of alcohol and opening times are 09:00 to 01:00hrs, Sunday – Thursday and 09:00 – 02:00hrs on Friday and Saturday.

On the 7th September 2017, Cleveland Police received an application to transfer the premises licence from John Taylor to a Mr Eric Hill.

Cleveland Police have concerns regarding Mr Hill taking over as Premises Licence holder of the premises and believe that should this application be granted the licensing objectives may be undermined.

At 5.13am on Sunday 27th August 2017 a call was made to Cleveland police from a person who claimed they had been at the premises and had overheard people snorting 'cocaine' in the toilets as well as talking about using the drug.

This person has approached doorstaff who have allegedly consulted with other staff members and have asked the caller of this incident to leave.

This incident is alleged to have occurred approximately 10 minutes prior to it being reported to Cleveland Police.

I have attached a copy of this incident which I exhibit as JRJ/1.

Unfortunately no Police unit attended the premises but as can be seen on the incident report, CCTV from the local authority monitored the premises and reported that they could see someone in Manhattans. This is time stamped at 05:22hrs.

This has occurred on the morning of a highly publicized boxing event taking place in America with the event starting around 05:00hrs British Summer time.

There had not been any Temporary Event Notice (TEN) submitted by any person for this premises for this specific event as opposed to other premises who did stay open for the event and did submit a TEN.

At 11:45hrs on Thursday 31st August 2017 I was on duty in company with Pc1237 Craig when we attended the premises in order to check the CCTV from the 27th August.

We spoke to Eric Hill at the venue and checked for any footage from that evening but the CCTV was only recording for 5 days and the last images recorded were at 13:45hrs on the 27th August so there was no footage from earlier that morning.

I was informed by Mr Hill that there had been a 'power cut' which meant that any images prior to this had been lost.

This premise has a condition relating to the CCTV system and this states that CCTV footage must be kept for a minimum of 31 days.

As a result of this I requested CCTV footage from the local authority which shows persons inside Manhattans as well as leaving the premises during the early hours of the 27th August from around 5:44hrs onwards.

This footage lasts for 1 hour and during that time numerous persons are seen exiting Manhattans and leave in motor vehicles that are parked outside or by taxi or walk away from the premises on foot.

This is more than 4 hours after the premises should have closed.

I have copied this footage onto a playable format and I exhibit this as JRJ/2.

At 2.40pm on Tuesday 5th September 2017 I was on duty in company with Sgt944 Higgins when we attended the premises to see if the CCTV was recording for longer than the 5 days from my previous visit.

On checking the system it was still only recording images for 5 days.

At 11.48am on Friday 8th September 2017 I received a text message from Lisa McParland who is the new DPS of Manhattans stating that the CCTV has now been fixed and will be recording for 30 days.

I have subsequently contacted John Taylor as the premises licence holder as he is ultimately responsible in this role.

He has informed me that he has little or no control of the premises and that the person I would need to speak to is Mr Eric Hill.

Mr Taylor told me that he intended to transfer the licence and this was subsequently followed by the application to transfer it to Mr Hill.

At 1.09pm on Wednesday 27th September I was on duty in company with Pc894 Thorpe when we conducted a recorded interview with Mr Hill at Middlesbrough Police station regarding the offence of carrying out unlicensable activities on the 27th August 2017.

I have asked for till records from this evening but as of the date of this statement I have not received any such records from Mr Hill.

At 10.50am on Friday 29th September 2017 I was on duty in company with Pc1237 Craig when we attended the premises.

This was to check the CCTV as according to the text received on the 8th September the system was now recording correctly so there should be at least 21 days footage.

I spoke to Mr Hill at the premises but on checking the CCTV the only images recorded went back to September 23rd which is only 7 days of footage.

Given the nature of the events of the 27th August 2017 and Mr Hill's involvement in this as well as the CCTV which was only recording for 5 days at this time, Cleveland Police are of the opinion that by allowing him to transfer the Premises Licence into his name may undermine the licensing objectives.

As Cleveland Police lodged an objection against the transfer of the premises licence the matter was considered at a meeting of the Statutory Licensing Committee held on 10th October 2017.

Preliminary

The Chair introduced all persons who were present and explained the procedure that would be followed.

The Committee gave consideration to the report, the application and the representation which had been received from Cleveland Police. The Committee heard oral submissions from the parties who were in attendance at the meeting.

The Committee noted that the application was for Premises Licence to be transferred to Eric Hill. Cleveland Police were satisfied that exceptional circumstances applied and that granting the application would, in their view, undermine the crime prevention objective.

Applicant

Mr Hill stated that he had leased the premise with effect from 29th June 2017.

He noted the Polices objection but when he took over the lease he relied on the previous DPS and his trust in her had been misguided. He was under the impression that the previous DPS had lodged a Temporary Event Notice (TEN) for the boxing but this had not been done. Mr Hill stated that as it was not possible within the timescale to go through the TEN process he decided to show the boxing to his friends and family as he had spent several hundred pounds paying for the broadcast at the premise.

He noted that there had been an issue with the provision of CCTV footage to the Police but he believed this problem was caused by the electrics tripping and that he had raised this issue with his landlord. The landlord had promised that he would provide a statement confirming this but he had not done so.

Mr Hill stated that the male who had made the call to the Police alleging use of cocaine by customers in the toilets was also know to him and he had said he was willing to give a statement as he had informed Mr Hill that he had made the call maliciously after being asked to leave the premise. Mr Hill confirmed that he had not obtained a statement from this person.

Mr Hill stated that the premise does not tolerate drug use and the staff do a toilet check every 20 minutes.

Mr Hill stated that since the issues at the premise there is a new DPS and they also have a new door company operating.

Cleveland Police were given an opportunity to ask question of Mr Mill.

Mr Hill was asked why it had taken him so long to apply to transfer the premises licence if he had taken over control of the premise at the end of June

Mr Hill was questioned on his understanding of the licensing objectives and the conditions of the premises licence.

Mr Hill was questioned on the records being kept at the premise which the Police alleged were lacking. As an example Sergeant Higgins stated that Mr Hill had been asked to provide till receipts for the night in question but had been unable to do so.

Mr Hill was questioned on why the male was ejected from the premise. Mr Hill confirmed that he had been drunk and had been in the premise for many hours.

Cleveland Police

Sergeant Higgins on behalf of Cleveland police stated that since Mr Hill has taken over the lease of the premise they have concerns in the manner in which the premise has operated. Evidence has been presented to the Committee to show that unauthorised licensable activities have taken place at the premise when the boxing was shown. That is a serious matter and on conviction can result in up to 6 months imprisonment or a £20,000 fine or both. Evidence shows that the premise has been trading in breach of its licence conditions as CCTV was not operating as it should and training records were not completed appropriately. The Police are particularly concerned that the CCTV appears to have been wiped from the system. In the opinion of the Police even if there is a power cut it does not wipe the memory. There are two explanations for this it's either been done deliberately by the management or its sheer incompetence. In the Polices view the management of the premise is simply not good enough. Cleveland Police were satisfied that this was an exceptional circumstance where they felt they had sufficient evidence to object to the transfer of the premises licence.

Mr Hill did not have any questions of Cleveland Police.

The Committee asked for clarification as to why Cleveland Police had not taken any action to review the premises licence as at the present time and until this transfer takes effect Mr John Taylor is the current premise licence holder.

Sergeant Higgins advised that if a premise had breached its licence conditions then they would firstly try to work with the Premise in order to identify and address and issues which they had and give the premise an opportunity to improve. If that did not work then the Police would seek a review of the Premises Licence.

Summing Up

All parties were given an opportunity to sum up with Mr Hill having the final submission.

Members Decision Making

The Committee had regard to the legislation and the statutory guidance under Section 182 of the Licensing Act. In particular the Committee noted paragraphs 8.97 – 8.100 of the Guidance which detailed the transfer process and when the Police could object.

The Committee had regard to the application and noted that a representation had been received from Cleveland Police who were of the view that there were exceptional circumstances to object to the application.

The Committee considered all of the evidence but were mindful that as this was an application for a transfer of a premises licence they could only approve or refuse. The Committee were mindful that this was not a review and therefore they had no power to vary the terms of the licence or attach conditions. If it had been a review application the Committee would have been minded to take action against the licence as Mr Hill had instilled little faith in the Committee.

The Committee were also mindful of the Statutory Guidance and what specific legal considerations applied. The Committee had to consider whether there was sufficient evidence to find that Mr Hill or businesses or individuals linked to him are involved in crime (or disorder). In the opinion of the Committee these powers, given they are only to be used by the Police in exceptional circumstances, are as noted in the Guidance intended to address persons or businesses involved in crime. Although the Committee did not condone the manner in which the premises had operated since Mr Hill had taken over the lease this was not in their opinion a situation which would fulfil the test of crime under the Legislation and Guidance. Notwithstanding that view the Committee did share the concerns which the Police had expressed. The manner in which Mr Hill had presented his evidence to the Committee was of serious concern. Mr Hill had done little to instil any confidence in his ability to manage the premise effectively. However it was noted that Mr Hill had given a number of assurances that improvements have been made and continue to be made at the premise. The Committee hope those assurances are with merit and that improvements continue to be made.

After giving due consideration to all relevant information the Committee decided to reluctantly approve the application as detailed.

The Committee advised Mr Hill that he should take on board what he had heard today as it was clear his initial management of the premises was a cause for concern and that he would no doubt be closely monitored by Cleveland Police and the Councils Licensing Section. If Mr Hill did not fulfil his responsibilities under the Licensing Act then he would be likely to see his licence been subject to a review. Mr Hill was advised to strongly heed this warning.

If you are aggrieved by this decision you may appeal to the Teesside Magistrates Court within 21 days of receipt of this letter. If you are considering whether to submit an appeal I would advise you to seek your own independent legal advice. If any appeal is not successful then the Magistrates have the power to award costs against the unsuccessful appellant.

Hi,

I just thought I would drop you an email in case my IL doesn't reach your department for some reason.

I have dealt with a Sec 18 assault that occurred at Manhattans pub on Stockton High Street today which occurred at 04:30 hours at a "lock in". I have been told that there were around ten people in there at that time that were still being served and an assault occurred causing a female to have a two inch cut on her forehead that needed stitches. When I went to check the CCTV they were a bit cagey about showing me and when I did see it the camera that covers the area where they were sat and where the assault took place had been moved to point at the ceiling. It looks like it had been moved between 02:15 hours and 02:25 hours just after closing time I was told by staff. The camera is too high to be accidentally knocked and I think that it was moved to hide the "lock in" from the CCTV. It would appear that the assault would have been caught on that camera and now vital evidence has been lost.
