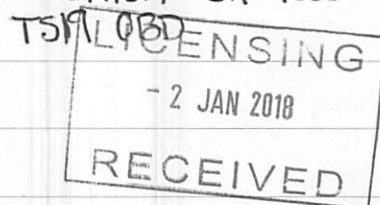

The night I was assaulted for no reason I was punched and stamped on. If it was not for the licensee pushing the male off me when I was on the floor things could have been a lot worse due to me just having major surgery on September the 17th for a perforated bowel. The male in question was arrested the same night. At the end of the day no one myself or anyone else had spoke to the male. He had no reason to assault me in no shape or form. Regardless of what anyone else could have done the assault of being punched and stamped on while on the floor could not have been avoided or foreseen happening by either me, my daughter or the licensee. I still feel safer being in this public house than the others up the other end of the town. I still believe Manhattans is one of the safest pubs in the town for me and my daughter or my daughter on her own to be in on a night out and I could not fault anyone in regards to Manhattans.

To whom it may concern;

My name is Nicole Banthorpe. On the 07/12/17 after my day at college I had gone to the Ramsgate Pub to meet my father (Jason Banthorpe) at about quarter past six. When the Ramsgate closed at Seven o'clock we left to go through the high street to Manhattans, with Zee the barmaid a friend of hers Luke Casey. We had been in Manhattans for about an hour stood at the bar with friends when a younger male male approached and proceeded to assault my father from behind for no apparent reason. This caused my dad to fall to the floor where the young male proceeded to stamp on his head a few times then follow up with a few more punches before stamping on his head a final time. At this time due to shock I was hysterical. While the attack was happening Lisa ran from behind the bar and pushed the male off of my father, he then fled from the premises. The police were immediately called. The male had assaulted my father for no reason as my father had done nothing wrong, he hadn't even spoke to him nor even made eye contact at all. My father is disabled due to a back problem and arthritis. He has recently had major surgery for a perforated bowel. We go to Manhattans as it is at the top end of the town as we feel un safe at the bottom end due to all the trouble that goes on. We go to Manhattans as it is full of good company. You can see that the apperance is improving due to the money and effort they are putting in. Due to the assault on my father I fear my mental health has been impacted as I am waking up

due to flash backs due to the incident. This has caused me to spend more time with my father due to me being anxious about him. This has resulted in me checking up on him often. As I have previously stated the attack was completely unprovoked, unfortunately my father was just in the wrong place at the wrong time. Manhattans staff could not have done anything more than they did and certainly couldn't have anticipated the actions that followed from the young male. When out for a drink I feel the safest in Manhattans so it would be a real shame for it to be shut down or sanctioned in anyway.

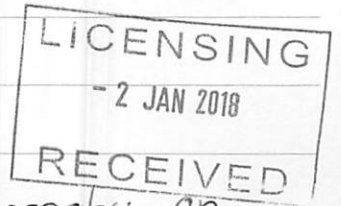
