I HAVE NO OBJECTION IN PRINCIPLE TO A LICENSED RESTAURANT AT THESE PREMISES BUT THE LICENCE APPLIED FOR APPEARS TO ALLOW ACTIVITIES OVER AND ABOVE A RESTAURANT. THE LICENCE IF GRANTED WOULD IN EFFECT AUTHORISE A PUBLIC HOUSE.

THERE IS CONSIDERABLE CONCERN ABOUT THE DEVELOPMENT OF NORTON AS A COMMERCIAL VENUE FOR PUBS, WINE BARS, ETC (SEE E.G. THE EVENING GAZETTE 13.3.2011 "WHAT'S HAPPENED TO NORTON? FEAR ON STREETS AMID ANTI-SOCIAL CRIME SPIKE")
MY FEAR IS THAT IF FURTHER 'PUB LICENCES'

ARE ALLOWED, ESPECIALLY IN THE AREA OF THE GREEN, THE PROBLEM WILL MOVE FROM THE MORE COMMERCIAL SOUTHERN END OF THE HIGH STREET TO THE RESIDENTIAL NORTHERN END.

THIS CONCERN WAS ACKNOWLEDGED IN THE CASE OF AN APPLICATION FOR BLACKWELLS BUTCHERS AT 122 HIGH STREET NORTON WHICH WAS DETERMINED ON 8th SEPTEMBER 2017 WHEN CONDITIONS WERE ATTACHED TO A LICENCE RESTRICTING THE NUMBER OF DINERS AT THE PREMISES, RESTRICTING THE NUMBER OF PRE-PLANNED EVENTS (NOT APPLICABLE TO THE VIOLET GREEN) BUT MOST IMPORTANTLY LIMITING ^{OPENING} HOURS MONDAY - SATURDAY TO 10.30, + 8.30 ON SUNDAYS, AND HOURS OF SALES TO 9.00 (MONDAY + TUESDAYS) AND TO 10.00 (WEDNESDAYS TO SATURDAYS). I BELIEVE THIS ESTABLISHED AN IMPORTANT PRECEDENT WHICH SHOULD BE FOLLOWED IN THIS CASE.

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
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THE GREEN (WHICH ADJOINS THIS PROPERTY)
