To Whom it my Concern

I live at the above address with my 3 children aged 17, 10 and 9.

We are aware of the current plans to turn 2 High Newham Road in to a pub and we have great objection to this plans with it been so close to our family home we have lived at this address now for 15 years and it is a lovely home for our children we have a lovely safe back garden for them to play in. This pub is around 15 feet away from my property at the widest point and around 6 feet away at the closest. The proposed beer garden would be less that a foot as it would be my fence that sets the boundary to this.

The plans for this pub will impact massively on our family life.

The proposed owner of the establishment came to my door after a Facebook post went out stating that he was opening this pub and he was planning to have live music, DJs and karaoke. The noise level of this will be heard in my family home and garden. He stated that this would not be an issue however, I disagree with him as my children's bedroom is close to the designated area where he is wanting an outdoor beer garden, the doors to this garden will be open and the noise from inside the pub will be heard which will impact on my children's sleep.

This pub is at the widest point around 15 feet from my house and at the closest point around 6 feet from my children's bedroom.

If live music is to be played there late at night how can they say this will not be heard in my home.

Live music will consist of bands how can they keep that noise level low when the bass sound will travel.

It states that unreasonable noise after 11am and before 7am can consist of loud music and other house hold noise and loud groups is inappropriate during these hours.

if this pub is open to the public till 12am will this not be classed as inappropriate noise from customers drinking outside and smoking.

Also if this venue shuts at 12am then there is still the staff to clear up and shut the premise up with means pulling down shutters late at night this can be heard from the inside of my property with it been so close.

Under the Environmental Protection Act 1990 a statutory nuisance is something that will affect a person's health or cause disturbance to them enjoying time in their property or land for example in their home or garden.

- Live music and people congregating outside my property to the side where my garden is, which is a safe and secure place for my children will be affected by this noise pollution from music and people been allowed to drink and smoke outside the premises.
- Also, he is proposing to put a beer garden at the other side of my fence close to my back garden and house. The only thing that will separate the beer garden and my garden and home is my boundary fence so all the noise of people drinking outside the establishment will be heard my children bedrooms over looks on to this beer garden and will defiantly causes issues to my young children getting to sleep and will cause a massive disturbance to them.
- This will then impact on their health and wellbeing as they will lose out on sleep when they have to be up early the next day for school and even on a weekend they cannot relax due to noise pollution. My husband also has to be up early at 4am to go to work this will impact on him as the noise levels late in to the night will stop him from sleeping his job means he has to work weekends and is up early even on these days.
- On sunny days there will be many people sat outside in this beer garden and my children will have to listen to all the loud rowdy noise all day and night. There will be bad and vulgar language used and the more people drink the louder and rowdier this noise will become. I don't see how the proposed landlord can police this matter of keeping them quite and I don't think it is fair that my children have to listen to foul language all day and cannot play in their garden without listening to this.
- I work all week and enjoy some down time in my garden on a weekend with my children we have a lovely relaxing garden and I am now not going to have that with all the noise that will be projected from this pub and beer garden.
- How can the landlord police the noise levels outside in the beer garden.
- And how can they stop people from been loud and using foul language when sitting in their beer garden?
- My children's bedrooms are at the back and front of the house. They will hear this and due to the estate that this pub is opening on we have quite a lot of trouble here when people start drinking as well this will just amplify the matter and I can image they will be many fight outside my property. We had the same issues when the Hardwick pub was open from people walking past and this was not right next door to my property this pub actually encroaches up to my property.
- If during the summer it is a warm night we like to have out windows open to let some air in our rooms we will not be able to do this now as their will be a lot of noise coming from the beer garden and the pub itself. This will stop my children from sleeping when they have to get up for school I do not think this is fair on my children and the lack off sleep can impact significantly on their health and wellbeing.
- Research has shown that outdoor second hand smoke is also bad for people the University of Stanford recently done a study and this showed that smoking affects air quality at sidewalk café pubs park benches and other outdoor locations it concluded that people are likely to be expose to substantial levels of contaminated air. Second hand smoke is detectable at 23 feet away from the source of the smoker my children will be closer to these smokers with them been so close to my garden. It is said that anyone who is positioned downwind from the outdoor source of secondhand smoke will be exposed even at a significant distance it is well

- established that second hand smoke can increase the rates of asthma, respiratory track infections, ear infections and sudden infant death syndrome.
- Why is this ok for my children to be exposed to this on a daily basis all day and night especially during the summer months when my children spend most days in the garden when neither myself or my husband smoke and do not expose our children to this?
- Opening this pub will have massive impact on my family and will be detrimental to us all we will have no quiet time in our garden with out children as they will always be noise from the beer garden and the pub itself.

I would like to Object to the granting of the application for a license for the above premises, under the following categories

Prevention of Crime and disorder Prevention of Public nuisance Protection of children from harm Public safety

I am deeply concerned for the impact it will have on the Crime in the area as well as the residents living within close proximity.

We have an increasing drug problem in the area mainly situated at the Hardwick Shops directly behind this proposed establishment. There are often a large group of young people who hang around at the

"Chip shop" next door and they would be subjected to foul language and adult conversations/behaviour from the intoxicated customers who will be sitting outside as well as those entering and leaving.

I am concerned that the seating area that is planned for the front of the building runs alongside a public path which people use to visit the local shops and access a bus stop, I feel the public could feel intimidated and possibly face abuse from intoxicated customers. This will have a negative impact on the elderly and those people with young children, its an inappropriate area for outdoor seating/drinking.

I am concerned around the parking issues that we already have without adding to this from the customers that would be visiting the establishment. The landlord himself will often park on the double yellow lines showing complete disregard for them.

I am concerned around the noise pollution we will face as neighbours, The Hardwick has advertised DJs, Karaoke and live music events all of which will impact on the noise level including the vibrations from this which will impact the residents ability to rest and relax in their own homes and gardens. I am also worried about the noise level and behaviour of intoxicated customers when leaving the venue after closing and waiting for taxis or generally finishing their socialising with each other outside. People who live on the estate will most probably walk past my house as it's a main route on the estate this was also the case when the old Hardwick pub was running.

I am concerned around the damage to property and cars as people walk past very late at night, intoxicated and the unpredictable behaviour of people under the influence of alcohol.
